~ **Messianic** ... **Prophecy** ... **Christ** - God is my salvation, I shall trust in him and be in no dread, Yehowah is my strength and my might, he saved me' (**Isaiah 12:2**) ^[43] - References

Isaiah 12:2 Look! God is my salvation. I shall trust and be in no dread, for Yah, Yehowah is my strength and my might, and he came to be the salvation of me.

^[43] - References

- Trust in **Yehowah**, you people, for all times, for in **Yah, Yehowah** is the Rock of times indefinite. (**Isaiah 26:4**)
- As for Israel, he will certainly be saved in union with **Yehowah** with a **salvation** for times indefinite. You people will not be ashamed, nor will you be humiliated for the indefinite times of eternity. (**Isaiah 45:17**)
- Anyone dwelling in the secret place of the Most High will procure himself lodging under the very shadow of the Almighty One. (**Psalms 91:1**)
- Do gather back, O **Yehowah**, our company of captives, like streambeds in the Negeb. (**Psalms 126:4**)
- **Yah** is my shelter and my **might**, and to me he becomes **salvation**. (**Psalms 118:14**)
- But as for me, with the voice of thanksgiving I will sacrifice to you. What I have vowed, I will pay. Salvation belongs to Yehowah. (**Jonah 2:9**)
- And they keep on crying with a loud voice, saying; Salvation we owe to our **God**, who is seated on the throne, and to the Lamb. (**Revelation 7:10**)
- For all things I have the **strength** by virtue of him who imparts power to me. (**Philippians 4:13**)
- If anyone speaks, let him speak as it were the sacred pronouncements of **God**, if anyone ministers, let him minister as dependent on the **strength** that **God** supplies, so that in all things **God**

may be glorified through Jesus Christ. The glory and the **might** are his forever and ever. Amen. (**1 Peter 4:11**)

- But to the house of Judah I shall show mercy, and I will save them by **Yehowah** their **God**, but I shall not save them by a bow or by a sword or by war, by horses or by horsemen. (**Hosea 1:7**)

- My **strength** and **my might** is **Yah**, since he serves for my **salvation**. This is my **God**, and I shall laud him, my father's **God**, and I shall raise him on high. (**Exodus 15:2**)

- Saying; Because a hand is against the throne of **Yah**, **Yehowah** will have war with Amalek from generation to generation. (**Exodus 17:16**)

- Happy you are, O Israel! Who is there like you, a people enjoying **salvation** in **Yehowah**, the shield of your help, and the One who is your eminent sword? So your enemies will cringe before you, and you, upon their high places you will tread. (**Deuteronomy 33:29**)

- Then **Yehowah** said to Joshua; Do not be afraid or be terrified. Take with you all the people of war and get up, go up to Ai. See, I have given into your hand the king of Ai and his people and his city and his land. (**Joshua 8:1**)

- My **God** is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my horn of **salvation**, my secure height, and my place for flight, my Savior, from violence you save me. (**2 Samuel 22:3**)

- The true **God** is my strong fortress, and he will cause my way to be perfect. (**2 Samuel 22:33**)

- He would also be my **salvation**, for before him no apostate will come in. (**Job 13:16**)

- I shall have affection for you, O **Yehowah** my **strength**. (**Psalms 18:1**)

- He will carry away blessing from **Yehowah** and righteousness from his **God** of **salvation**. (**Psalms 24:5**)

- **Yehowah** is my light and my **salvation**. Of whom shall I be in fear? **Yehowah** is the stronghold of my life. Of whom shall I be in **dread**? (**Psalms 27:1**)

- **Yehowah** is my **strength** and my shield. In him my heart has trusted, and I have been helped, so that my heart exults, and with my song I shall laud him. (**Psalms 28:7**)

- And draw spear and double ax to meet those pursuing me. Say to my soul; I am your salvation. (**Psalms 35:3**)
- And the **salvation** of the righteous ones is from **Yehowah**, he is their fortress in the time of distress. (**Psalms 37:39**)
- Do make haste to my assistance, O **Yehowah** my **salvation**. (**Psalms 38:22**)
- Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O **God** the **God** of my **salvation**, that my tongue may joyfully tell about your righteousness. (**Psalms 51:14**)
- O my Strength, to you I will make melody, for **God** is my secure height, the **God** of loving-kindness to me. (**Psalms 59:17**)
- Indeed he is my rock and my **salvation**, my secure height, I shall not be made to totter very much. (**Psalms 62:2**)
- The true **God** is for us a **God** of saving acts, and to **Yehowah** the Sovereign Lord belong the ways out from death. (**Psalms 68:20**)
- O **Yehowah**, the **God** of my **salvation**, by day I have cried out, in the night also in front of you. (**Psalms 88:1**)
- The stone that the builders rejected has become the head of the corner. (**Psalms 118:22**)
- You are my Divine One, and I shall laud you, my God, I shall exalt you. (**Psalms 118:28**)
- On the day that I called, you also proceeded to answer me, you began to make me bold in my soul with **strength**. (**Psalms 138:3**)
- For your confidence to come to be in **Yehowah** himself I have given you knowledge today, even you. (**Proverbs 22:19**)
- Place me as a seal upon your heart, as a seal upon your arm, because love is as strong as death is, insistence on exclusive devotion is as unyielding as Sheol is. Its blazings are the blazings of a fire, the flame of **Yah**. (**Song of Solomon 8:6**)
- And the full moon has become abashed, and the glowing sun has become ashamed, for **Yehowah** of armies has become king in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem and in front of his elderly men with glory. (**Isaiah 24:23**)
- For **Yehowah** is our Judge, **Yehowah** is our Statute-giver, **Yehowah** is our King, he himself will save us. (**Isaiah 33:22**)

- I, I am **Yehowah**, and besides me there is no savior. (**Isaiah 43:11**)
- I have brought near my righteousness. It is not far away, and my own **salvation** will not be late. And I will give in Zion **salvation**, to Israel my beauty. (**Isaiah 46:13**)
- My righteousness is near. My **salvation** will certainly go forth, and my own arms will judge even the peoples. In me the islands themselves will hope, and for my arm they will wait. (**Isaiah 51:5**)
- Truly the hills as well as the turmoil on the mountains belong to falsehood. Truly in **Yehowah** our **God** is the **salvation** of Israel. (**Jeremiah 3:23**)
- If it is to be, our **God** whom we are serving is able to rescue us. Out of the burning fiery furnace and out of your hand, O king, he will rescue us. (**Daniel 3:17**)
- But as for me, it is for **Yehowah** that I shall keep on the lookout. I will show a waiting attitude for the **God** of my **salvation**. My **God** will hear me. (**Micah 7:7**)
- Yet, as for me, I will exult in **Yehowah** himself, I will be joyful in the **God** of my **salvation**. (**Habakkuk 3:18**)
