- But **you** have approached a Mount **Zion** and a city of the living God, heavenly Jerusalem, and myriads of angels. (**Hebrews 12:22**)
- And I saw, and, look! The Lamb standing upon the Mount **Zion**, and with him a hundred and forty-four thousand having his name and the name of his Father written on their foreheads. (**Revelation 14:1**)
- The **stone** that the builders rejected **has** become the head of the **corner**. (**Psalms 118:22**)
- As it is written; Look! **I am laying** in **Zion** a **stone** of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense, but he that rests his **faith** on it **will** not come to disappointment. (**Romans 9:33**)
- For it is contained in Scripture: Look! **I am laying** in **Zion** a **stone**, chosen, a **foundation** cornerstone, **precious**, and no one **exercising faith** in it **will** by any means come to disappointment. (**1 Peter 2:6**)
- For it was fitting for the one for whose sake all things are and through whom all things are, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the Chief Agent of their salvation perfect through sufferings. (**Hebrews 2:10**)
- And after he had been made perfect he became responsible for everlasting salvation to all those obeying him. (**Hebrews 5:9**)
- Jesus **said** to them; Did **you** never read in the Scriptures: The **stone** that the builders rejected is the one that **has** become the chief

cornerstone. From **Yehowah** this **has** come to be, and it is marvelous in our eyes? (**Matthew 21:42**)

- Did **you** never read this scripture: The **stone** that the builders rejected, this **has** become the chief cornerstone. (**Mark 12:10**)
- But he looked upon them and **said**; What, then, does this that is written mean: The **stone** which the builders rejected, this **has** become the chief cornerstone? (**Luke 20:17**)
- This is the **stone** that was treated by **you** builders as of no account that **has** become the head of the corner. (**Acts of Apostles 4:11**)
- And I shall put my words in your mouth, and with the shadow of my hand I shall certainly cover you, in order to plant the heavens and lay the **foundation** of the earth and say to **Zion**, You are my people. (**Isaiah 51:16**)
- Also, I say to you; You are Peter. And on this rock-mass I **will** build my congregation, and the gates of Hades **will** not overpower it. (**Matthew 16:18**)
- For no man can lay any other **foundation** than what is laid, which is Jesus Christ. (**1 Corinthians 3:11**)
- And **you** have been built up upon the **foundation** of the apostles and prophets, while Christ Jesus himself is the **foundation** cornerstone. (**Ephesians 2:20**)
- As it is written; Look! I **am laying** in **Zion** a **stone** of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense, but he that rests his **faith** on it **will** not come to disappointment. (**Romans 9:33**)
- For the Scripture says; None that rests his **faith** on him **will** be disappointed. (**Romans 10:11**)
- For it is contained in Scripture: Look! I **am laying** in **Zion** a **stone**, chosen, a **foundation** cornerstone, **precious**, and no one **exercising faith** in it **will** by any means come to disappointment. (**1 Peter 2:6**)
- And yet his bow was dwelling in a permanent place, and the strength of his hands was supple. From the hands of the powerful one of Jacob, from there is the shepherd, the **stone** of Israel. (**Genesis 49:24**)

- Accordingly the king commanded that they should quarry great **stones**, expensive **stones**, to lay the **foundation** of the house with hewn **stones**. (**1 Kings 5:17**)
- And he must become as a sacred place, but as a **stone** to strike against and as a rock over which to stumble to both the houses of Israel, as a trap and as a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. (**Isaiah 8:14**)
- And what **will** anyone say in answer to the messengers of the nation? That **Yehowah** himself **has** laid the **foundation** of **Zion**, and in her the afflicted ones of his people **will** take refuge. (**Isaiah 14:32**)
- For it is not Sheol that can laud you, death itself cannot praise you. Those going down into the pit cannot look hopefully to your trueness. (**Isaiah 38:18**)
- Look! The **Sovereign Lord Yehowah** himself **will** help me. Who is there that can pronounce me wicked? Look! All of them, like a garment, **will** wear out. A mere moth **will** eat them up. (**Isaiah 50:9**)
- For **YOU** people **will get** out in no panic, and **YOU will** go in no flight. For **Yehowah will** be going even before **you**, and the God of Israel **will** be **YOUR** rear guard. (**Isaiah 52:12**)
- For I myself, **Yehowah**, shall speak what word I shall speak, and it **will** be done. There **will** be no postponement anymore, for in **YOUR** days, O rebellious house, I shall speak a word and certainly do it, is the utterance of the **Sovereign Lord Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 12:25**)
- Forasmuch as you beheld that out of the mountain a **stone** was cut not by hands, and that it crushed the iron, the copper, the molded clay, the silver and the gold. The grand God himself **has** made known to the king what is to occur after this. And the dream is reliable, and the interpretation of it is trustworthy. (**Daniel 2:45**)
