- For there **has** been a child born to us, there **has** been a son given to us. The princely rule **will** come to be upon his shoulder. His **name will** be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (**Isaiah 9:6**)
- Look! A king **will** reign for righteousness itself, and as respects princes, they **will** rule as princes for justice itself. (**Isaiah 32:1**)
- I kept on beholding in the visions of the night, and, see there! With the clouds of the heavens someone like a son of **man** happened to be coming, and to the Ancient of Days he gained access, and they brought him up close even before that One. (**Daniel 7:13**)
- O sword, awake against my shepherd, even against the able-bodied **man** who is my associate, is the utterance of **Yehowah of armies**. Strike the shepherd, and let those of the flock be scattered, and I shall **certainly** turn my hand back upon those who are insignificant. (**Zechariah 13:7**)
- Now, when the army officer that was standing by with him in view saw he had expired under these circumstances, he **said**; Certainly this **man** was God's Son. (**Mark 15:39**)
- Accordingly Jesus came outside, wearing the thorny crown and the purple outer garment. And he **said** to them; Look! The man! (**John 19:5**)
- And there must go forth a twig out of the stump of Jesse, and out of his roots a **sprout will** be fruitful. (**Isaiah 11:1**)

- Hear, please, O Joshua the High Priest, you and your companions who are sitting before you, for they are men serving as portents, for here I am bringing in my servant **Sprout!** (**Zechariah 3:8**)
- This one **will** be great and **will** be called Son of the Most High, and **Yehowah** God **will** give him the throne of David his father. (**Luke 1:32**)
- This is **what Yehowah of armies has said**; Let the hands of **you** people be strong, **you** who are hearing in these days these words from the mouth of the prophets, on the day on which the foundation of the house of **Yehowah of armies** was laid, for the **temple** to be built. (**Zechariah 8:9**)
- Also, I **say** to you, You are Peter, and on this rock-mass I **will build** my congregation, and the gates of Hades **will** not overpower it. (**Matthew 16:18**)
- And **you** have been built up upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, while Christ Jesus himself is the foundation cornerstone. (**Ephesians 2:20**)
- But Christ was faithful as a Son over the house of that One. We are the house of that One, if we make fast our hold on our freeness of speech and our boasting over the hope firm to the end. (**Hebrews 3:6**)
- And here I am thinking of building a house to the **name** of **Yehowah** my God, just as **Yehowah** promised to David my father, saying; Your son whom I shall put upon your throne in **place** of you, he is the one that **will build** the house to my name. (**1 Kings 5:5**)
- In those days and at that time I shall make **sprout** for David a righteous **sprout**, and he **will certainly** execute justice and righteousness in the land. (**Jeremiah 33:15**)
- And all the trees of the field **will** have to know that I myself, **Yehowah**, have abased the high tree, have put on high the low tree, have dried up the still-moist tree and have made the dry tree blossom. I myself, **Yehowah**, have spoken and have done it. (**Ezekiel 17:24**)
- The very hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house, and his **own** hands **will** finish it. And you **will** have to know that **Yehowah of armies** himself **has** sent me to **you** people. (**Zechariah 4:9**)
- Philip found Nathanael and **said** to him; We have found the one of whom Moses, in the Law, and the Prophets wrote, Jesus, the son of Joseph, from Nazareth. (**John 1:45**)

- In union with him the whole building, being harmoniously joined together, is growing into a holy temple for Yehowah. (Ephesians 2:21)
- For the latter is counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as he who constructs it has more honor than the house. (Hebrews 3:3)
- Concerning this very salvation a diligent inquiry and a careful search were made by the prophets who prophesied about the undeserved kindness meant for you. (1 Peter 1:10)
