- Let those be ashamed and abashed all together who are joyful at my calamity. Let those be clothed with **shame** and humiliation who are assuming great airs against me. (Psalms 35:26)
- Let those resisting me be clothed with humiliation, and let them enwrap themselves with their **shame** just as with a sleeveless coat. (Psalms 109:29)
- So I stood over him and definitely put him to death, for I knew that he could not live after he had fallen. Then I took the **diadem** that was upon his head and the bracelet that was upon his arm, that I might bring them to my lord here. (2 Samuel 1:10)
- Then he brought the son of the king out and put upon him the **diadem** and the Testimony, and so they made him king and anointed him. And they began to clap their hands and say; Let the king live! (2 Kings 11:12)
- Then they brought the king's son out and put upon him the **diadem** and the Testimony and made him king, and so Jehoiada and his sons anointed him and said; Let the king live! (2 Chronicles 23:11)
- Saying; I, even I, have installed my king upon Zion, my holy mountain. (Psalms 2:6)
- And he **will** have subjects from sea to sea and from the River to the ends of the earth. (Psalms 72:8)
- For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule **will** come to be upon his shoulder. His name **will** be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)
