

**CHRIST - I HAVE HEARD A BAD REPORT, FRIGHT ALL AROUND**

~ **Messianic ... Prophecy ... Christ** - I have heard a bad report fright all around, they mass together against me to take away my soul they do scheme' (**Psalms 31:13**) <sup>[12]</sup> - References

**Psalms 31:13**· For I have heard the bad report by many, fright being on all sides. When they mass together as one against me, it is to take away my soul that they do scheme.

<sup>[12]</sup> - References

- For I **heard** the **bad report** of **many**. There was **fright** all around. **TELL** out, that we may tell out about him. Every mortal man bidding me Peace! They are watching for my limping; Perhaps he will be fooled, so that we may prevail **against** him and **take** our revenge upon him. (**Jeremiah 20:10**)
- Then they started to accuse him, saying; This man we found subverting our nation and forbidding the paying of taxes to Caesar and saying he himself is Christ a king. (**Luke 23:2**)
- My **soul** is in the middle of lions, I cannot but lie down among devourers, even the sons of men, whose teeth are spears and arrows, and whose tongue is a sharp sword. (**Psalms 57:4**)
- Do not go out into the field, and do not walk even in the way, for there is the sword belonging to the enemy, there is **fright** all around. (**Jeremiah 6:25**)
- Also, the chief priests and the scribes were seeking the effective way for them to get rid of him, for they were in fear of the people. (**Luke 22:2**)
- So the multitude of them rose, one and all, and led him to Pilate. (**Luke 23:1**)
- When it had become morning, all the chief priests and the older men of the people held a consultation **against** Jesus so as to put him to death. (**Matthew 27:1**)
- For it is not peace that they speak, but **against** the quiet ones of the earth things of deception they keep scheming. (**Psalms 35:20**)

- Unitedly **against** me all those hating me whisper to one another, **against** me they keep scheming something **bad** for me. (**Psalms 41:7**)
- But it came about on the following day that Pashhur proceeded to let Jeremiah out from the stocks, and Jeremiah now said to him; Yehowah has called your name, not Pashhur, but Fright all around. (**Jeremiah 20:3**)
- Their own tents and their own flocks will be taken, their tent cloths and all their articles. And their own camels will be carried off from them. And they will certainly cry out to them, Fright is all around! (**Jeremiah 49:29**)
- Now when it became day, the Jews formed a conspiracy and bound themselves with a curse, saying they would neither eat nor drink until they had killed Paul. (**Acts of Apostles 23:12**)
