- For I have heard the **bad report** by **many**, **fright** being on all sides. When they mass together as one **against** me, it is to **take** away my soul that they do scheme. **(Psalms 31:13)**
- There was written in it: Among the nations it has been heard, and Geshem is saying it, that you and the Jews are scheming to rebel. That is why you are building the wall, and you are becoming a king to them, according to these words. **(Nehemiah 6:6)**
- Where there is one covering over hatred there are lips of falsehood, and the one bringing forth a **bad report** is stupid. **(Proverbs 10:18)**
