Isaiah 41:25· I have roused up someone from the north, and he will come. From the rising of the sun he will call upon my name. And he will come upon deputy rulers as if they were clay and just as a potter that tramples down the moist material.

- The One saying of Cyrus: He is my shepherd, and all that I delight in he **will** completely carry out. Even in my saying of Jerusalem: She **will** be rebuilt. And of the temple: You **will have** your foundation laid. (**Isaiah 44:28**)
- This is what Yehowah has said to his anointed one, to Cyrus, whose right hand I **have** taken hold of, to subdue before him nations, so that I may ungird even the hips of kings, to open before him the two-leaved doors, so that even the gates **will** not be shut. (**Isaiah 45:1**)
- The One calling from the sunrising a bird of prey, from a distant land the man to execute my counsel. I **have** even spoken it, I shall also bring it in. I **have** formed it, I shall also do it. (**Isaiah 46:11**)
- And the sixth one poured out his bowl upon the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, that the way might be prepared for the kings from the **rising** of the **sun**. (**Revelation 16:12**)
- Against an apostate nation I shall send him, and against the people of my fury I shall issue a command to him, to take much spoil and to take much plunder and to make it a trampling place like the **clay** of the streets. (**Isaiah 10:6**)
- And out of his mouth there protrudes a sharp long sword, that he may strike the nations with it, and he **will** shepherd them with a rod of iron. He treads too the winepress of the anger of the wrath of God the Almighty. (**Revelation 19:15**)

- Thus it happened to him like that, when the people kept trampling him in the gateway, so that he died. (**2 Kings 7:20**)
- They were the **potters** and the inhabitants of Netaim and Gederah. It was with the king in his work that they dwelt there. (**1 Chronicles 4:23**)
- Look! Someone **will come up just** like a lion from the proud thickets along the Jordan to the durable abiding place, but in a moment I shall make them run away from her. And the one who is chosen I shall appoint over her. For who is like me, and who **will** challenge me, and who, now, is the shepherd that can stand before me? (**Jeremiah 50:44**)
- And I **will** execute acts of judgment in Egypt, and they **will have** to know that I am Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 30:19**)
