Psalms 119:60 I hurried up, and I did not delay to keep your commandments.

- Immediately Moses and Aaron did so, just as Yehowah had commanded, and he lifted up the rod and struck the water that was in the Nile River under the eyes of Pharaoh and his servants, and all the water that was in the Nile River was turned into blood. (**Exodus 7:20**)

- In this very day Abraham got circumcised, and also Ishmael his son. (**Genesis 17:26**)
- So Abraham got up early in the morning and took bread and a skin water bottle and gave it to Hagar, setting it upon her shoulder, and the child, and then dismissed her. And she went her way and wandered about in the wilderness of Beersheba. (**Genesis 21:14**)
