Psalms 145:1 I will exalt you, O my God the King, and I will bless your name to time indefinite, even forever.

[15] - References

- You yourself are my **King**, O **God**. Command grand salvation for Jacob. (**Psalms 44:4**)
- For Yehowah is our Judge, Yehowah is our Statute-giver, Yehowah is our **King**, he himself **will** save us. (**Isaiah 33:22**)
- The king was answering Daniel and saying; Truly the **God** of you men is a **God** of gods and a Lord of kings and a Revealer of secrets, because you were able to reveal this secret. (**Daniel 2:47**)
- Saying; We thank you, Yehowah **God**, the Almighty, the One who is and who was, because you have taken your great power and begun ruling as king. (**Revelation 11:17**)
- Consequently David blessed Yehowah before the eyes of all the congregation and David said; Blessed may you be, O Yehowah the **God** of Israel our father, from time **indefinite even** to time **indefinite**. (**1 Chronicles 29:10**)
- And the women began to say to Naomi; Blessed be Yehowah, who has not let a repurchaser fail for you today, that his **name** may be proclaimed in Israel. (**Ruth 4:14**)
- And David went on to say to all the congregation; Bless, now, Yehowah **YOUR** God. And all the congregation proceeded to **bless** Yehowah the **God** of their forefathers and bow low and prostrate themselves to Yehowah and to the king. (**1 Chronicles 29:20**)
- And the Levites Jeshua and Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabneiah, Sherebiah, Hodiah, Shebaniah and Pethahiah went on to say; Rise, **bless** Yehowah **YOUR** God from time **indefinite** to time **indefinite**. And

let them **ble**ss your glorious **name**, which is exalted above all blessing and praise. (**Nehemiah 9:5**)

- Do pay attention to the sound of my cry for help, O my **King** and my **God**, because to you I pray. (**Psalms 5:2**)
- Who, then, is he, this glorious **King**? Yehowah of armies, he is the glorious **King**. (**Psalms 24:10**)
- So I **will** make melody to your **name forever**, that I may pay my vows day after day. (**Psalms 61:8**)
- Come into his gates with thanksgiving, into his courtyards with praise. Give thanks to him, **ble**ss his **name**. (**Psalms 100:4**)
- You are my Divine One, and I shall laud you, my God, I shall **exalt** you. (**Psalms 118:28**)
- O Yehowah, you are my **God**. I **exalt** you, I laud your **name**, for you have done wonderful things, counsels from early times, in faithfulness, in trustworthiness. (**Isaiah 25:1**)
- For all the peoples, for their part, **will** walk each one in the **name** of its god, but we, for our part, shall walk in the **name** of Yehowah our **God** to time **indefinite, even forever**. (**Micah 4:5**)
