Psalms 119:46· I will also speak about your reminders in front of kings, and I shall not be ashamed.

· Then Nathan said to David; You yourself are the man! This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; I myself anointed you as king over Israel, and I myself delivered you out of the hand of Saul. (**2 Samuel 12:7**)

· Your own reminders have proved very trustworthy. Holiness is befitting to your own house, O Yehowah, for length of days. (**Psalms 93:5**)

· I have kept your orders and your reminders, for all my ways are in front of you. (**Psalms 119:168**)

· And as for you, his son Belshazzar, you have not humbled your heart, although you knew all this. (**Daniel 5:22**)

· Why, you will be haled before governors and kings for my sake, for a witness to them and the nations. (**Matthew 10:18**)

· Concerning all the things of which I am accused by Jews, King Agrippa, I count myself happy that it is before you I am to make my defense this day. (**Acts of Apostles 26:2**)

· For whoever becomes ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of man will also be ashamed of him when he arrives in the glory of his Father with the holy angels. (**Mark 8:38**)

· For I am not ashamed of the Good News, it is, in fact, God's power for salvation to everyone having faith, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. (**Romans 1:16**)

· And afterward Moses and Aaron went in and proceeded to say to Pharaoh; This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; Send my

people away that they may celebrate a festival to me in the wilderness. (Exodus 5:1)

· Listen, you kings, give ear, you high officials; I to Yehowah, yes, I, will sing. I shall make melody to Yehowah, Israel's God. (Judges 5:3)

· And Shaphan the secretary went on to report to the king, saying; There is a book that Hilkiyah the priest gave me. And Shaphan began to read out of it before the king. (2 Chronicles 34:18)

· I shall laud you with all my heart. In front of other gods I shall make melody to you. (Psalms 138:1)

· Therefore, O king, may my counsel seem good to you, and remove your own sins by righteousness, and your iniquity by showing mercy to the poor ones. Maybe there will occur a lengthening of your prosperity. (Daniel 4:27)

· At that time Daniel was answering and saying before the king; Let your gifts prove to be to you yourself, and your presents do you give to others. However, I shall read the writing itself to the king, and the interpretation I shall make known to him. (Daniel 5:17)

· In harmony with my eager expectation and hope that I shall not be ashamed in any respect, but that in all freeness of speech Christ will, as always before, so now be magnified by means of my body, whether through life or through death. (Philippians 1:20)
