Isaiah 16:5 And in loving-kindness a throne will certainly be firmly established, and one must sit down upon it in trueness in the tent of David, judging and seeking justice and being prompt in righteousness.

- Why have the nations been in tumult and the national groups themselves kept muttering an empty thing? (**Psalms 2:1**)
- The kings of earth take their stand and high officials themselves have massed together as one against Yehowah and against his anointed one. (**Psalms 2:2**)
- Saying; Let us tear their bands apart and cast their cords away from us! (**Psalms 2:3**)
- The very One sitting in the heavens **will** laugh, Yehowah himself **will** hold them in derision. (**Psalms 2:4**)
- At that time he **will** speak to them in his anger and in his hot displeasure he **will** disturb them. (**Psalms 2:5**)
- Saying; I, even I, have installed my king upon Zion, my holy mountain. (**Psalms 2:6**)
- Let me refer to the decree of Yehowah, he has said to me You are my son, I, today, I have become your father. (**Psalms 2:7**)
- Ask of me, that I may give nations as your inheritance and the ends of the earth as your own possession. (**Psalms 2:8**)
- You **will** break them with an iron scepter, as though a potter's vessel you **will** dash them to pieces. (**Psalms 2:9**)
- And now, O kings, exercise insight, let yourselves be corrected, O judges of the earth. (**Psalms 2:10**)

- Serve Yehowah with fear and be joyful with trembling. (**Psalms 2:11**)
- Kiss the son, that He may not become incensed and **you** may not perish from the way, for his anger flares up easily. Happy are all those taking refuge in him. (**Psalms 2:12**)
- And in the days of those kings the God of heaven **will** set up a kingdom that **will** never be brought to ruin. And the kingdom itself **will** not be passed on to any other people. It **will** crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, and it itself **will** stand to times indefinite. (**Daniel 2:44**)
- Look! A king **will** reign for righteousness itself, and as respects princes, they **will** rule as princes for **justice** itself. (**Isaiah 32:1**)
- And each one **must** prove to be like a hiding place from the wind and a place of concealment from the rainstorm, like streams of water in a waterless country, like the shadow of a heavy crag in an exhausted land. (**Isaiah 32:2**)
- And I saw the heaven opened, and, look! A white horse. And the one seated upon it is called Faithful and True, and he judges and carries on war in righteousness. (**Revelation 19:11**)
- His eyes are a fiery flame, and upon his head are many diadems. He has a name written that no one knows but he himself. (**Revelation 19:12**)
- And he is arrayed with an outer garment sprinkled with blood, and the name he is called is The Word of God. (**Revelation 19:13**)
- Also, the armies that were in heaven were following him on white horses, and they were clothed in white, clean, fine linen. (**Revelation 19:14**)
- And out of his mouth there protrudes a sharp long sword, that he may strike the nations with it, and he **will** shepherd them with a rod of iron. He treads too the winepress of the anger of the wrath of God the Almighty. (**Revelation 19:15**)
- And upon his outer garment, even upon his thigh, he has a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords. (**Revelation 19:16**)
- No bruised reed **will** he crush, and no smoldering flaxen wick **will** he extinguish, until he sends out **justice** with success. (**Matthew 12:20**)
- Indeed, in his name nations **will** hope. (**Matthew 12:21**)

- For Yehowah is a lover of **justice**, and he **will** not leave his loyal ones. To time indefinite they **will certainly** be guarded, but as for the offspring of the wicked ones, they **will** indeed be cut off. (**Psalms 37:28**)
- Look! A king **will** reign for righteousness itself, and as respects princes, they **will** rule as princes for **justice** itself. (**Isaiah 32:1**)
- So his servants said to him; Here, now, we have heard that the kings of the house of Israel are kings of **loving-kindness**. Please, let us carry sackcloth upon our loins and ropes upon our heads, and let us go out to the king of Israel. Perhaps he **will** preserve your soul alive. (**1 Kings 20:31**)
- The voice of a joyful cry and salvation is in the **tents** of the righteous ones. The right hand of Yehowah is demonstrating vital energy. (**Psalms 118:15**)
- Loving-kindness and trueness, they safeguard the king, and by **loving-kindness** he has sustained his **throne**. (**Proverbs 20:28**)
- Let there be the removing of the wicked one before the king, and his **throne will** be **firmly established** by righteousness itself. (**Proverbs 25:5**)
- To the abundance of the princely rule and to peace there **will** be no end, upon the **throne** of **David** and upon his kingdom in order to establish it **firmly** and to sustain it by means of **justice** and by means of righteousness, from now on and to time indefinite. The very zeal of Yehowah of armies **will** do this. (**Isaiah 9:7**)
- In that day I shall raise up the booth of **David** that is fallen, and I shall **certainly** repair their breaches. And its ruins I shall raise up, and I shall **certainly** build it up as in the days of long ago. (**Amos 9:11**)
