~ **Messianic ... Prophecy ... Christ** - In peace I will lie down and sleep, O Yehowah, you make me dwell in security' (**Psalms 4:8**) ^[11] -
References

Psalms 4:8 In peace I will both lie down and sleep, for you yourself alone, O Yehowah, make me dwell in security.

[11] - References

- As for me, I **will lie down** that I may **sleep**, I shall certainly awake, for **Yehowah** himself keeps supporting me. (**Psalms 3:5**)
- Whenever you **lie down** you **will** feel no dread, and you **will** certainly **lie down**, and your **sleep** must be pleasurable. (**Proverbs 3:24**)
- So **YOU** must carry out my statutes and **YOU** should keep my judicial decisions and **YOU** must carry them out. Then **YOU will** certainly **dwell** on the land in **security**. (**Leviticus 25:18**)
- And **YOU** must cross the Jordan and **dwell** in the land that **Yehowah YOUR** God is giving **YOU** as a possession, and he **will** certainly give **YOU** rest from all **YOUR** enemies round about, and **YOU will** indeed **dwell** in **security**. (**Deuteronomy 12:10**)
- And I **will** conclude with them a covenant of peace, and I shall certainly cause the injurious wild beast to cease out of the land, and they **will** actually **dwell** in the wilderness in **security** and **sleep** in the forests. (**Ezekiel 34:25**)
- And I **will** put peace in the land, and **YOU will** indeed **lie down**, with no one making **YOU** tremble, and I **will make** the injurious wild beast cease out of the land, and a sword **will** not pass through **YOUR** land. (**Leviticus 26:6**)
- As to Benjamin he said; Let the beloved one of **Yehowah** reside in **security** by him, while he shelters him the whole day, and he must reside between his shoulders. (**Deuteronomy 33:12**)
- And **Yehowah** proceeded to send Jerubbaal and Bedan and Jephthah and Samuel and deliver **YOU** out of the hand of **YOUR** enemies all around, that **YOU** might **dwell** in **security**. (**1 Samuel 12:11**)

- To no avail it is for **you** men that **you** are rising up early, that **you** are sitting **down** late, that **you** are eating food with pains. Just like this he gives **sleep** even to his beloved one. (**Psalms 127:2**)
- Sweet is the **sleep** of the one serving, regardless of whether it is little or much that he eats, but the plenty belonging to the rich one is not permitting him to **sleep**. (**Ecclesiastes 5:12**)
- Now, look! A great agitation arose in the sea, so that the boat was being covered by the waves, he, however, was sleeping. (**Matthew 8:24**)
