· After these things I saw, and, look! A great crowd, which no man was able to number, out of all nations and tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, dressed in white robes, and there were palm branches in their hands. **(Revelation 7:9)**

· And I saw another angel flying in midheaven, and he had everlasting Good News to declare as glad tidings to those who dwell on the earth, and to every nation and tribe and tongue and people. **(Revelation 14:6)**

· And in reply the king will say to them; Truly I say to you, to the extent that you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me. **(Matthew 25:40)**

· But he is a Jew who is one on the inside, and his circumcision is that of the heart by spirit, and not by a written code. The praise of that one comes, not from men, but from God. **(Romans 2:29)**

· Moreover, if you belong to Christ, you are really Abraham's seed, heirs with reference to a promise. **(Galatians 3:29)**

· And a vast mixed company also went up with them, as well as flocks and herds, a very numerous stock of animals. **(Exodus 12:38)**

· Then Moses said to Hobab the son of Reuel the Midianite, the father-in-law of Moses; We are pulling away for the place about which Yehowah said; I shall give it to you. Do come with us, and we shall

certainly do good to you, because **Yehowah has** spoken good concerning Israel. (**Numbers 10:29**)

- And Ruth proceeded to say; Do not plead with me to abandon you, to turn back from accompanying you, for where you **go** I shall **go**, and where you spend the night I shall spend the night. Your **people will** be my **people**, and your **God** my **God**. (**Ruth 1:16**)
- In fact, **Yehowah has** laid commandment upon us in these words, **I have** appointed you as a light of **nations**, for you to be a salvation to the extremity of the earth. (**Acts of Apostles 13:47**)
- For what great nation is there that **has** gods near to it the way **Yehowah** our **God** is in all our calling upon him? (**Deuteronomy 4:7**)
- This is what **Yehowah has said**; The unpaid laborers of Egypt and the merchants of Ethiopia and the Sabeans, tall **men, will** themselves come over even to you, and yours they **will** become. - And I **will** bless those who bless you, and him that calls down evil upon you I shall curse, and all the families of the ground **will** certainly bless themselves by means of you. (**Genesis 12:3**)
- Why, Abraham is surely going to become a nation great and mighty, and all the **nations** of the earth must bless themselves by means of him. (**Genesis 18:18**)
- And by means of your seed all **nations** of the earth **will** certainly bless themselves due to the fact that you **have** listened to my voice. (**Genesis 22:18**)
- To this they **said**; **We have** unmistakably seen that **Yehowah has** proved to be with you. Hence we **said**; Let, please, an oath of obligation occur between us, between us and you, and let us conclude a covenant with you. (**Genesis 26:28**)
- Foreigners themselves **will** come cringing to me, ears **will** be obedient to hear me. (**2 Samuel 22:45**)
- As he was going along from there he got to encounter Jehonadab the son of Rechab coming to meet him. When he blessed him, he

- And as regards those having insight among the **people**, they **will** impart understanding to the many. And they **will** certainly be made to stumble by sword and by flame, by captivity and by plundering, for some **days**. (**Daniel 11:33**)

- For then I shall give to **peoples** the change to a pure language, in order for them all to call upon the name of **Yehowah**, in order to serve him shoulder to shoulder. (**Zephaniah 3:9**)
