Isaiah 55:3· Incline **YOUR** ear and come to me. Listen, and **YOUR** soul will keep alive, and I shall readily conclude with **YOU** people an indefinitely lasting covenant respecting the loving-kindnesses to David that are faithful.

- A prophet from your own midst, from your brothers, like me, is what Yehowah your God **will** raise up for you, to him **you people** should listen. (**Deuteronomy 18:15**)
- In response to all that you asked of Yehowah your God in Horeb on the day of the congregation, saying; Do not let me hear again the voice of Yehowah my God, and this great fire do not let me see anymore, that I may not die. (**Deuteronomy 18:16**)
- At that Yehowah said to me, They have done well in speaking what they did. (**Deuteronomy 18:17**)
- A prophet I shall raise up for them from the midst of their brothers, like you, and I shall indeed put my words in his mouth, and he **will** certainly speak to them all that I shall command him. (**Deuteronomy 18:18**)
- And it must occur that the man who **will** not listen to my words that he **will** speak in my name, I shall myself require an account from him. (**Deuteronomy 18:19**)
- For I, Yehowah, am loving justice, hating robbery along with unrighteousness. And I **will** give their wages in trueness, and an **indefinitely lasting covenant** I shall **conclude** toward them. (**Isaiah 61:8**)
- Do give **ear**, O my **people**, to my Law, incline **YOUR ear** to the sayings of my mouth. (**Psalms 78:1**)

- Everything the Father gives me **will come** to me, and the one that **comes** to me I **will** by no means drive away. (**John 6:37**)
- Draw close to God, and he **will** draw close to **YOU**. Cleanse **YOUR** hands, **YOU** sinners, and purify **YOUR** hearts, **YOU** indecisive ones. (**James 4:8**)
- I advise you to buy from me gold refined by fire that you may become rich, and white outer garments that you may become dressed and that the shame of your nakedness may not become manifested, and eyesalve to rub in your eyes that you may see. (**Revelation 3:18**)
- A wise person **will** listen and take in more instruction, and a man of understanding is the one who acquires skillful direction. (**Proverbs 1:5**)
- My son, to my words do pay attention. To my sayings incline your **ear**. (**Proverbs 4:20**)
- For is not my household like that with God? Because it is an **indefinitely lasting covenant** that he has assigned to me, nicely put in order in everything and secured. Because it is all my salvation and all my delight, is that not why he **will** make it grow? (**2 Samuel 23:5**)
- Now may the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great shepherd of the sheep with the blood of an everlasting **covenant**, our Lord Jesus. (**Hebrews 13:20**)
- And your house and your kingdom **will** certainly be steadfast to time indefinite before you, your very throne **will** become one firmly established to time indefinite. (**2 Samuel 7:16**)
- To time indefinite I shall preserve my loving-kindness toward him, and my **covenant will** be **faithful** to him. (**Psalms 89:28**)
- This is what Yehowah has said; If it was not a fact that I had appointed my own **covenant** of the day and night, the statutes of heaven and earth. (**Jeremiah 33:25**)
- And that fact that he resurrected him from the dead destined no more to return to corruption, he has stated in this way, I **will** give **YOU** **people** the **loving-kindnesses** to **David** that are faithful. (**Acts of Apostles 13:34**)
- I myself shall become his father, and he himself **will** become my son, and my loving-kindness I shall not remove from him the way I removed it from the one that happened to be prior to you. (**1 Chronicles 17:13**)

- Remember your mercies, O Yehowah, and your **loving-kindnesses**, for they are from time indefinite. (**Psalms 25:6**)
- Where are your former acts of loving-kindness, O Yehowah, about which you swore to **David** in your faithfulness? (**Psalms 89:49**)
- Keep my commandments and continue living, and my Law like the pupil of your eyes. (**Proverbs 7:2**)
- Incline your **ear** and hear the words of the wise ones, that you may apply your very heart to my knowledge. (**Proverbs 22:17**)
- With a flood of indignation I concealed my face from you for but a moment, but with loving-kindness to time indefinite I **will** have mercy upon you, your Repurchaser, Yehowah, has said. (**Isaiah 54:8**)
- For the mountains themselves may be removed, and the very hills may stagger, but my loving-kindness itself **will** not be removed from you, nor **will** my **covenant** of peace itself stagger, Yehowah, the One having mercy upon you, has said. (**Isaiah 54:10**)
- For this is what Yehowah has said to the eunuchs that **keep** my Sabbaths and that have chosen what I have delighted in and that are laying hold of my **covenant**. (**Isaiah 56:4**)
- And they **will** certainly serve Yehowah their God and **David** their king, whom I shall raise up for them. (**Jeremiah 30:9**)
- And I **will conclude** with them an **indefinitely lasting covenant**, that I shall not turn back from behind them, for me to do them good, and the fear of me I shall put in their heart in order not to turn aside from me. (**Jeremiah 32:40**)
- Likewise could my own **covenant** be broken with **David** my servant so that he should not **come** to have a son ruling as king upon his throne, also with the Levites, the priests, my ministers. (**Jeremiah 33:21**)
- And I **will** raise up over them one shepherd, and he must feed them, even my servant **David**. He himself **will** feed them, and he himself **will** become their shepherd. (**Ezekiel 34:23**)
- And I **will conclude** with them a **covenant** of peace, and I shall certainly cause the injurious wild beast to cease out of the land, and they **will** actually dwell in the wilderness in security and sleep in the forests. (**Ezekiel 34:25**)

- And I **will conclude** with them a **covenant** of peace, an **indefinitely lasting covenant** is what there **will come** to be with them. And I **will** place them and multiply them and place my sanctuary in the midst of them to time indefinite. (**Ezekiel 37:26**)
- For this is what Yehowah has said to the house of Israel, Search for me, and **keep** living. (**Amos 5:4**)
- Should **you** not obey the words that Yehowah called out by means of the former prophets, while Jerusalem happened to be inhabited, and at ease, with her cities all around her, and while the Negeb and the Shephelah were inhabited? (**Zechariah 7:7**)
