- In your righteousness may you deliver me and provide me with escape. Incline to me your **ear** and **save** me. (**Psalms 71:2**)
- O Yehowah, do hear my voice. May your **ears** prove to be attentive to the voice of my entreaties. (**Psalms 130:2**)
- But I am afflicted and poor. Yehowah himself takes account of me. You are my assistance and the Provider of escape for me. O my God, do not be too late. (**Psalms 40:17**)

- **Incline your ear, O Yehowah, and hear. Open your eyes, O Yehowah, and see, and hear the words of Sennacherib that he has sent to taunt the living God. (2 Kings 19:16)**
- **Now, O my God, please, let your eyes prove to be opened and your ears attentive to the prayer respecting this place. (2 Chronicles 6:40)**
