- And Jesus called with a loud voice and said; Father, into your **hands I entrust** my spirit. When he had said this, he expired. (**Luke 23:46**)
- And they went on casting stones at Stephen as he made appeal and said; Lord Jesus, receive my spirit. (**Acts of Apostles 7:59**)
- My lips will cry out joyfully when I am inclined to make melody to you, even my soul that you **have redeemed**. (**Psalms 71:23**)
- The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A **God** of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice, Righteous and upright is he. (**Deuteronomy 32:4**)
- In order that, through two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for **God** to lie, we who **have** fled to the refuge may **have** strong encouragement to lay hold on the hope set before us. (**Hebrews 6:18**)
- And **Yehowah** went passing by before his face and declaring; Yehowah, **Yehowah**, a **God** merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abundant in loving-kindness and **truth**. (**Exodus 34:6**)

- But **Yehowah** is in **truth God**. He is the living **God** and the King to time indefinite. Because of his indignation the earth will rock, and no nations will hold up under his denunciation. (**Jeremiah 10:10**)
