- And they began to **say** one to the other; Unquestionably we are guilty with regard to our brother, because we saw the distress of his soul when he implored compassion on our part, but we did not listen. That is why this distress **has come** upon us. (**Genesis 42:21**)
- Arise, O woman, shed forth **light**, for your **light has come** and upon you the very glory of Yehowah **has** shone forth. (**Isaiah 60:1**)
- For, look! Darkness itself will cover the earth, and thick gloom the national groups, but upon you Yehowah will shine forth, and upon you his own glory will be seen. (**Isaiah 60:2**)
- And **nations** will certainly go to your **light**, and kings to the brightness of your shining forth. (**Isaiah 60:3**)
- But as for you, young child, you will be called a prophet of the Most High, for you will go in advance before Yehowah to make his ways ready. (**Luke 1:76**)
- To give knowledge of **salvation** to his people by forgiveness of their sins. (**Luke 1:77**)
- Because of the tender compassion of our God. With this compassion a daybreak will visit us from on high. (**Luke 1:78**)
- To give **light** to those sitting in darkness and death's shadow, to direct our feet prosperously in the way of peace. (**Luke 1:79**)

- For I do not want **you**, brothers, to be ignorant of this sacred secret, in order for **you** not to be discreet in your own eyes; that a dulling of sensibilities **has** happened in part to **Israel** until the full number of people of the **nations has come** in. (**Romans 11:25**)
- And in this manner all **Israel** will be saved. Just as it is written: The deliverer will **come** out of Zion and turn away ungodly practices from **Jacob**. (**Romans 11:26**)
- And this is the covenant on my part with them, when I take their sins away. (**Romans 11:27**)
- For I **say** that Christ actually became a minister of those who are circumcised in behalf of God's truthfulness, so as to verify the promises He made to their forefathers. (**Romans 15:8**)
- And that the **nations** might glorify God for his mercy. Just as it is written: That is why I will openly acknowledge you among the **nations** and to your name I will make melody. (**Romans 15:9**)
- I myself, Yehowah, **have** called you in righteousness, and I proceeded to take hold of your hand. And I shall safeguard you and give you as a covenant of the people, as a **light** of the **nations**. (**Isaiah 42:6**)
- Look! My **servant** whom I chose, my beloved, whom my soul approved! I will put my spirit upon him, and what justice is he will make clear to the **nations**. (**Matthew 12:18**)
- He will not wrangle, nor cry aloud, nor will anyone hear his voice in the broad ways. (**Matthew 12:19**)
- No bruised reed will he crush, and no smoldering flaxen wick will he extinguish, until he sends out justice with success. (**Matthew 12:20**)
- Indeed, in his name **nations** will hope. (**Matthew 12:21**)
- Because my eyes **have** seen your means of saving. (**Luke 2:30**)
- That you **have** made ready in the sight of all the peoples. (**Luke 2:31**)
- A **light** for removing the veil from the **nations** and a glory of your people Israel. (**Luke 2:32**)
- In fact, Yehowah **has** laid commandment upon us in these words, I **have** appointed you as a **light** of **nations**, for you to be a **salvation** to the **extremity** of the earth. (**Acts of Apostles 13:47**)

- When those of the **nations** heard this, they began to rejoice and to glorify the word of Yehowah, and all those who were rightly disposed for everlasting life became believers. (**Acts of Apostles 13:48**)
- Yehowah **has** made his **salvation** known, in the eyes of the **nations** he **has** revealed his righteousness. (**Psalms 98:2**)
- He **has** remembered his loving-kindness and his faithfulness to the house of **Israel**. All the ends of the earth **have** seen the **salvation** by our God. (**Psalms 98:3**)
- Shout in triumph to Yehowah, all **you** people of the earth. Be cheerful and cry out joyfully and make melody. (**Psalms 98:4**)
- And it must occur in the final part of the days that the mountain of the house of Yehowah will **become** firmly established above the top of the mountains, and it will certainly be lifted up above the hills, and to it all the **nations** must stream. (**Isaiah 2:2**)
- And it must occur in that day that there will be the root of Jesse that will be standing up as a signal for the peoples. To him **even** the **nations** will turn inquiringly, and his resting-place must **become** glorious. (**Isaiah 11:10**)
- Yehowah **has** bared his holy arm before the eyes of all the **nations**, and all the ends of the earth must see the **salvation** of our God. (**Isaiah 52:10**)

- He **has** remembered his loving-kindness and his faithfulness to the house of **Israel**. All the ends of the earth **have** seen the **salvation** by our God. (**Psalms 98:3**)
- That is why in the region of **light** they must glorify Yehowah, in the islands of the sea the name of Yehowah, the God of **Israel**. (**Isaiah 24:15**)
- And a spirit proceeded to bear me along and I began to hear behind me the sound of a great rushing; Blessed be the glory of Yehowah from his place. (**Ezekiel 3:12**)

- And they began to **say** to the woman; We do not believe any longer on account of your talk, for we **have** heard for ourselves and we know that this man is for a certainty the savior of the world. (**John 4:42**)

- As long as I am in the world, I am the world's **light**. (**John 9:5**)
- And not for the nation only, but in order, that the children of God who are scattered about he might also gather together in one. (**John 11:52**)
- In fact, Yehowah **has** laid commandment upon us in these words, I **have** appointed you as a **light** of **nations**, for you to be a **salvation** to the **extremity** of the earth. (**Acts of Apostles 13:47**)
- And you are persuaded that you are a guide of the blind, a **light** for those in darkness. (**Romans 2:19**)
