- My instruction will drip as the rain, my saying will trickle as the dew, as gentle rains upon grass and as copious showers upon vegetation. (**Deuteronomy 32:2**)
- The raging of a king is a growling like that of a maned young lion, but his goodwill is like the dew upon the vegetation. (**Proverbs 19:12**)
- The Sidonians used to call **Hermon** Sirion, and the Amorites used to call it Senir. (**Deuteronomy 3:9**)
- From Aroer, which is on the bank of the torrent valley of Arnon, up to Mount Sion, that is to say, **Hermon**. (**Deuteronomy 4:48**)
- As for the sons of the half tribe of Manasseh, they dwelt in the land from Bashan to Baal-hermon and Senir and Mount **Hermon**. They themselves became numerous. (**1 Chronicles 5:23**)
- Jerusalem, as **mountains** are all around it, so **Yehowah** is all around his people from now on and to time **indefinite**. (**Psalms 125:2**)
- In that case I shall certainly command my **blessing** for **you** in the sixth year, and it must yield its crop for three years. (**Leviticus 25:21**)
- **Yehowah** will decree for you the **blessing** on your stores of supply and every undertaking of yours, and he will certainly bless you in the land that **Yehowah** your God is giving you. (**Deuteronomy 28:8**)
- Life he asked of you. You gave it to him, length of days to time **indefinite, even** forever. (**Psalms 21:4**)
- With me from Lebanon, O bride, with me from Lebanon may you come. May you descend from the top of Anti-Lebanon, from the top of
