

Zephaniah 1:8 And it must occur on the day of Yehowah's sacrifice that I will give attention to the princes, and to the sons of the king, and to all those wearing foreign attire.

[5] - References:

- To this he said; It means peace. To **sacrifice** to Yehowah is why I have come. Sanctify yourselves, and **you** must come with me to the sacrifice. Then he sanctified Jesse and his **sons**, after which he called them to the **sacrifice**. (**1 Samuel 16:5**)
- And Zedekiah's **sons** they slaughtered before his eyes, and Zedekiah's eyes he blinded, after which he bound him with copper fetters and brought him to Babylon. (**2 Kings 25:7**)
- So now do swear to me by Yehowah that you **will** not cut off my seed after me and that you **will** not annihilate my name out of the house of my father. (**1 Samuel 24:21**)
- And the **king** of Babylon proceeded to slaughter the **sons** of Zedekiah in Riblah before his eyes, and all the nobles of Judah the **king** of Babylon slaughtered. (**Jeremiah 39:6**)
- He now said to the one who was over the wardrobe; Bring out garments for all the worshipers of Baal. So he brought the **attire** out for them. (**2 Kings 10:22**)
