

Zephaniah 2:10~ This is what they will have instead of their pride, because they reproached and kept putting on great airs against the people of Yehowah¹ of armies.

1· This will be what they will be left with, instead of their pride, because they reproached, and put on great airs, against the people of Yehowah God, his true spirit anointed Christian remnant, so as to continue supporting their own religious lies.

[Question] What will they then be left with, and why, for how have they treated the true spirit anointed Christian congregation?

2· We have heard of the pride of Moab, that he is very proud, his haughtiness and his pride and his fury, his empty talk will not be so. (Isaiah 16:6)

[Question] What did Isaiah speak out against Moab, for how did Moab behave towards God's people Israel?

3· We have heard of the pride of Moab, he is very haughty, of his highness and of his pride, and of his haughtiness, and of the loftiness of his heart. (Jeremiah 48:29)

[Question] What was Moab known primarily for, and who conforms to this behavior today in modern day Christendom?

4· The presumptuousness of your heart is what has deceived you, you who are residing in the retreats of the crag, the height where he dwells, saying in his heart; Who will bring me down to the earth? (Obadiah 1:3)

[Question] What did Obadiah state, had deceived the men of Edom?

5· And it must occur, that when Yehowah terminates all his work in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem, I shall make an accounting for the fruitage of the insolence of the heart of the king of Assyria, and for the self-importance of his loftiness of eyes. (Isaiah 10:12)

[Question] Who did Yehowah God state through Isaiah, that he would make an accounting with, and why?

6· Whom have you taunted and spoken of abusively? And against whom have you lifted up your voice, and do you

raise your eyes on high? It is **against** the Holy One of Israel! (**Isaiah 37:23**)

[Question] How did Yehowah God feel upon hearing the taunting words of the king of Assyria?

- 7· **And you must say; I shall go up **against** the land of open rural country. I shall come in upon those having no disturbance, dwelling in security, all of them dwelling without wall, and they do not **have** even bar and doors. (**Ezekiel 38:11**)**

[Question] How does Gog of Magog feel about conquering the open land, they then dwelling in peacefulness at the end of the thousand years?

- 8· **Look! The wages due the workers who harvested **YOUR** fields, but which are held up by **YOU**, keep crying out, and the calls for help on the part of the reapers, **have** entered into the ears of **Yehowah** of **armies**. (**James 5:4**)**

[Question] Whose calls for assistance did James show, that Yehowah God would surely hear?

- 9· **In like manner, **YOU** younger men, be in subjection to the older men. But all of **YOU** gird yourselves with lowliness of mind toward one another, because God opposes the haughty ones, but he gives undeserved kindness to the humble ones. (**1 Peter 5:5**)**

[Question] What should all Christian men subject themselves to, how should they all treat one another?

[Question] How does Yehowah God feel about anyone behaving haughtily toward others?
