- And I went on to say; Ah, Yehowah the God of the heavens, the God great and **fear-inspiring**, keeping the covenant and loving-kindness toward those loving him and keeping his commandments. (**Nehemiah 1:5**)
- And I **will** remove the names of the Baal images from her mouth, and they **will** no longer be remembered by their name. (**Hosea 2:17**)
- And it must occur in that day, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, that I shall cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they **will** no more be remembered, and also the prophets and the spirit of uncleanness I shall cause to pass out of the land. (**Zechariah 13:2**)
- All the ends of the **earth will** remember and turn back to Yehowah. And all the families of the **nations will bow down** before you. (**Psalms 22:27**)
- Before him the inhabitants of waterless regions **will bow down**, and his very enemies **will** lick the dust itself. (**Psalms 72:9**)
- For from the sun's rising even to its setting my name **will** be great among the **nations**, and in every **place** sacrificial smoke **will** be made, a presentation **will** be made to my name, even a clean gift, because my name **will** be great among the nations, Yehowah of armies has said. (**Malachi 1:11**)
- He **will** not grow dim nor be crushed until he sets justice in the **earth** itself, and for his Law the **islands** themselves **will** keep waiting. (**Isaiah 42:4**)

- Listen to me, O **you islands**, and pay attention, **you** national groups far away. Yehowah himself has called me even from the belly. From the inward parts of my mother he has made mention of my name. (**Isaiah 49:1**)
- And I must pass through the land of Egypt on this night and strike every firstborn in the land of Egypt, from man to beast, and on all the **gods** of Egypt I shall execute judgments. I am Yehowah. (**Exodus 12:12**)
- Then the Ashdodites got up early the very next day, and there Dagon was fallen upon his face to the **earth** before the ark of Yehowah. So they took Dagon and returned him to his **place**. (**1 Samuel 5:3**)
- Come, **you people**, and see the activities of God. His dealing with the sons of men is **fear-inspiring**. (**Psalms 66:5**)
- The haughty eyes of earthling man must become low, and the loftiness of men must **bow down**, and Yehowah alone must be put on high in that day. (**Isaiah 2:11**)
- That is why in the region of light they must glorify Yehowah, in the **islands** of the sea the name of Yehowah, the God of Israel. (**Isaiah 24:15**)
- This is what **you** men **will** say to them; The **gods** that did not make the very heavens and the **earth** are the ones who **will** perish from the **earth** and from under these heavens. (**Jeremiah 10:11**)
- Tell it among the **nations** and publish it. And lift up a signal, publish it. Hide nothing, O men. Say, Babylon has been captured. Bel has been put to shame. Merodach has become terrified. Her images have been put to shame. Her dungy idols have become terrified. (**Jeremiah 50:2**)
