

Zephaniah 3:12 And I shall certainly let remain in the midst of you a people humble and lowly, and they will actually take refuge in the name of Yehowah.

[14] - References:

- For this is what the High and Lofty One, who is residing forever and whose name is holy, has said; In the height and in the holy place is where I reside, also with the one crushed and lowly in spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly ones and to revive the heart of the ones being crushed. (Isaiah 57:15)
- The spirit of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah is upon me, for the reason that Yehowah has anointed me to tell Good News to the meek ones. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to those taken captive and the wide opening of the eyes even to the prisoners. (Isaiah 61:1)
- Happy are those conscious of their spiritual need, since the kingdom of the heavens belongs to them. (Matthew 5:3)
- But God chose the foolish things of the world, that he might put the wise men to shame, and God chose the weak things of the world, that he might put the strong things to shame. (1 Corinthians 1:27)
- The name of Yehowah is a strong tower. Into it the righteous runs and is given protection. (Proverbs 18:10)
- In order that, through two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have fled to the refuge may have strong encouragement to lay hold on the hope set before us. (Hebrews 6:18)
- And the humble people you will save, but your eyes are against the haughty ones, that you may bring them low. (2 Samuel 22:28)
- For you have become a stronghold to the lowly one, a stronghold to the poor one in the distress that he has, a refuge from the rainstorm, a shade from the heat, when the blast of the tyrannical ones is like a rainstorm against a wall. (Isaiah 25:4)
- And in that day one will certainly say; Look! This is our God. We have hoped in him, and he will save us. This is Yehowah. We

have hoped in him. Let us be joyful and rejoice in the salvation by him. (**Isaiah 25:9**)

- The foot **will** trample it down, the feet of the afflicted one, the steps of the **lowly** ones. (**Isaiah 26:6**)
- And I proceeded to shepherd the flock meant for the killing, in **YOUR** behalf, O afflicted ones of the flock. So I took for myself two staffs. The one I called Pleasantness, and the other I called Union, and I went shepherding the flock. (**Zechariah 11:7**)
- And it came to be broken in that day, and the afflicted ones of the flock who were watching me got to know in this way that it was the word of **Yehowah**. (**Zechariah 11:11**)
- Hence in answer he said to the two; Go **YOUR** way, report to John what **YOU** saw and heard; The blind are receiving sight, the lame are walking, the lepers are being cleansed and the deaf are hearing, the dead are being raised up, the poor are being told the Good News. (**Luke 7:22**)
- For all that, the solid foundation of God stays standing, having this seal: Yehowah knows those who belong to him. And: Let everyone naming the **name** of **Yehowah** renounce unrighteousness. (**2 Timothy 2:19**)
