

Zephaniah 3:15~ Yehowah has removed the judgments upon you. He has turned away your enemy. The king of Israel, Yehowah, is in the midst of you. You will fear calamity no more.

1· At that time the daughter of Jerusalem should rejoice, for Yehowah God has removed the judgments against her. Also he has turned away her enemy from before her gates, and no more will any enemy come up against her. Her Messianic King is residing in her midst, she will certainly fear calamity no more to time indefinite.

[Question] Why then, should the daughter of Zion rejoice?

[Question] Who also has he turned away from her gates, and who now resides within her gates?

2· **SPEAK to the heart of Jerusalem and call out to her that her military service **has** been fulfilled, that her error **has** been paid off. For from the hand of **Yehowah** she **has** received a full amount for all her sins. (**Isaiah 40:2**)**

[Question] What did Yehowah show Isaiah, that would then be completed toward his people?

3· And it must occur, that just as **you became a malediction among the nations, O house of Judah and house of **Israel**, so I shall save **you**, and **you** must become a blessing. Do not be afraid. May **YOUR** hands be strong. (**Zechariah 8:13**)**

[Question] What did Zechariah show, that Israel had become among the nations, but how would that now change?

4· And my **enemy will see, and shame **will** cover her, who was saying to me; Where is he, **Yehowah** your God? My own eyes **will** look upon her. Now she **will** become a place of trampling, like the mire of streets. (**Micah 7:10**)**

[Question] What will now come upon her enemies that were reproaching her?

5· For here I am waving my hand against them, and they **will have to become spoil to their slaves. And **you** people **will** certainly know, that **Yehowah** of armies himself **has** sent me. (**Zechariah 2:9**)**

[Question] How would Yehowah God turn around their situation, and what would those once held as slaves become the masters over?

[Question] What would they know for certain once this happened?

- 6· **Who will file accusation against God's chosen ones? God is the One who declares them righteous. (Romans 8:33)**

[Question] Can anyone declare one of Yehowah God's spirit anointed Christian sons unrighteous, give reasons?

- 7· **For Yehowah is our Judge, Yehowah is our Statute-giver, Yehowah is our King, he himself will save us. (Isaiah 33:22)**

[Question] How did Isaiah show, what Yehowah God is to his people, and how they should view him?

- 8· **Round about there will be eighteen thousand cubits, and the name of the city from that day on will be, Yehowah Himself Is There. (Ezekiel 48:35)**

[Question] What will the city of Yehowah God then come to be called, and why?

- 9· **That is why they are before the throne of God, and they are rendering him sacred service day and night in his temple, and the One seated on the throne will spread his tent over them. (Revelation 7:15)**

[Question] Who come to be before the throne of God in the Revelation vision, and what do they render day and night to Yehowah God there?

[Question] What then, does he invite them into?

- 10· **And I shall certainly plant them upon their ground, and they will no more be uprooted from their ground, that I have given them, Yehowah your God has said. (Amos 9:15)**

[Question] What promise did Yehowah God make through Amos to his returning ones?

- 11· **And people will certainly inhabit her, and there will occur no more any banning to destruction, and Jerusalem must be inhabited in security. (Zechariah 14:11)**

[Question] Who will then come to inhabit Jerusalem, and what will never again happen to her?

- 12· So that anyone blessing himself in the earth, **will** bless himself by the God of faith, and anyone making a sworn statement in the earth, **will** swear by the God of faith, because the former distresses **will** actually be forgotten, and because they **will** actually be concealed from my eyes. **(Isaiah 65:16)**

[Question] Who then, will people bless and swear by alone, in all the earth, and what days of the past will be completely forgotten?

- 13· For I myself well know the thoughts that I am thinking toward **you**, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, thoughts of peace, and not of **calamity**, to give **you** a future and a hope. **(Jeremiah 29:11)**

[Question] What kinds of thoughts does Yehowah God think toward his people, for what does he want for them to experience?

- 14· By reason of your saying; These two nations and these two lands, they **will** become my own, and we shall certainly take possession of each land, whereas **Yehowah** himself happened to be right there. **(Ezekiel 35:10)**

[Question] Who heard the plotting of nations like Edom and Ammon against his people Israel?

- 15· And **Yehowah** proceeded to answer the angel who was speaking with me, with good words, comforting words. **(Zechariah 1:13)**

[Question] How did the angel speak to Zechariah?
