[7] - References:

- Correspondingly, John came neither eating nor drinking, yet people say; He has a demon. (Matthew 11:18)
- This, because they were saying; He has an unclean spirit. (Mark 3:30)
- Correspondingly, John the Baptist has come neither eating bread nor drinking wine, but you say, He has a demon. (Luke 7:33)
- But when his relatives heard about it, they went out to lay hold of him, for they were saying; He has gone out of his mind. (Mark 3:21)
- The crowd answered; You have a demon. Who is seeking to kill you? (John 7:20)
- In answer the Jews said to him; Do we not rightly say; You are a Samaritan and have a demon? (John 8:48)
- The Jews said to him; Now we do know you have a demon. Abraham died, also the prophets, but you say, If anyone observes my word, he will never taste death at all. (John 8:52)
