[4] - References:

- **And took counsel** together to seize Jesus by crafty device and **kill** him. (**Matthew 26:4**)
- **Meantime the chief priests and the entire Sanhedrin were looking for false witness against Jesus in order to put him to death. (Matthew 26:59)**
- **On this account, indeed, the Jews began seeking all the more to kill** him, because not only was he breaking the Sabbath but he was also calling God his own Father, making himself equal to God. (**John 5:18**)
- **At that the Pharisees went out and immediately began holding council with the party followers of Herod against him, in order to destroy him. (Mark 3:6)**
