- So we, although many, are one body in **union** with Christ, but members belonging individually to one another. (**Romans 12:5**)
- Now I exhort **you**, brothers, through the name of our Lord Jesus Christ that **you** should all speak in agreement, and that there should not be divisions among **you**, but that **you** may be fitly united in the same mind and in the same line of thought. (**1 Corinthians 1:10**)
- There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor freeman, there is neither male nor female, for **you** are all one person in **union** with Christ Jesus. (**Galatians 3:28**)
- However, if we are walking in the light as he himself is in the light, we do have a sharing with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. (**1 John 1:7**)
- But if I **am** doing them, even though **you** do not **believe** me, **believe** the works, in **order** that **you** may come to know and may continue knowing that the **Father** is in **union** with me and I **am** in **union** with the **Father**. (**John 10:38**)
- Do you not **believe** that I **am** in **union** with the **Father** and the **Father** is in **union** with me? The things I say to **you** men I do not speak of my own originality, but the **Father** who remains in **union** with me is doing his works. (**John 14:10**)
- But he who is joined to the Lord is one spirit. (**1 Corinthians 6:17**)
- Because the sayings that you gave me I have given to them, and they have received them and have certainly come to know that I came out as your representative, and they have believed that you **sent** me forth. (**John 17:8**)
- In **union** with God I shall praise his word, in **union** with Yehowah I shall praise his word. (**Psalms 56:10**)

- **Look! How good and how pleasant it is for brothers to dwell together in unity! (Psalms 133:1)**
- **I and the Father are one. (John 10:30)**
- **And not for the nation only, but in order that the children of God who are scattered about he might also gather together in one. (John 11:52)**
- **In that day you will know that I am in union with my Father and you are in union with me and I am in union with you. (John 14:20)**
- **Also, I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world and I am coming to you. Holy Father, watch over them on account of your own name which you have given me, in order that they may be one just as we are. (John 17:11)**
- **Moreover, the multitude of those who had believed had one heart and soul, and not even one would say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common. (Acts of Apostles 4:32)**
- **Greet Andronicus and Junias my relatives and my fellow captives, who are men of note among the apostles and who have been in union with Christ longer than I have. (Romans 16:7)**
- **God is faithful, by whom you were called into a sharing with his Son Jesus Christ our Lord. (1 Corinthians 1:9)**
- **But I was unknown by face to the congregations of Judea that were in union with Christ. (Galatians 1:22)**
- **I am confident about you who are in union with the Lord that you will not come to think otherwise, but the one who is causing you trouble will bear his judgment, no matter who he may be. (Galatians 5:10)**
- **Children, be obedient to your parents in union with the Lord, for this is righteous. (Ephesians 6:1)**
- **To the holy ones and faithful brothers in union with Christ at Colossae; May you have undeserved kindness and peace from God our Father. (Colossians 1:2)**

- Therefore, as **YOU** have accepted Christ Jesus the Lord, go on walking in **union** with him. (**Colossians 2:6**)
- For **YOU** died, and **YOUR** life has been hidden with the Christ in **union** with God. (**Colossians 3:3**)
- Paul and Silvanus and Timothy to the congregation of the Thessalonians in **union** with God the **Father** and the Lord Jesus Christ; May **YOU** have undeserved kindness and peace. (**1 Thessalonians 1:1**)
- In **order** that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in **YOU**, and **YOU** in **union** with him, in accord with the undeserved kindness of our God and of the Lord Jesus Christ. (**2 Thessalonians 1:12**)
- But, after **YOU** have suffered a little while, the God of all undeserved kindness, who called **YOU** to his everlasting glory in **union** with Christ, will himself finish **YOUR** training, he will make **YOU** firm, he will make **YOU** strong. (**1 Peter 5:10**)
- That which we have seen and heard we are reporting also to **YOU**, that **YOU** too may be having a sharing with us. Furthermore, this sharing of ours is with the **Father** and with his Son Jesus Christ. (**1 John 1:3**)
- But whoever does observe his word, truthfully in this person the love of God has been made perfect. By this we have the knowledge that we are in **union** with him. (**1 John 2:5**)
- And as for **YOU**, the anointing that **YOU** received from him remains in **YOU**, and **YOU** do not need anyone to be teaching **YOU**, but, as the anointing from him is teaching **YOU** about all things, and is true and is no lie, and **just** as it has taught **YOU**, remain in **union** with him. (**1 John 2:27**)
- **You** originate with God, little children, and **YOU** have conquered those persons, because he that is in **union** with **YOU** is greater than he that is in **union** with the **world**. (**1 John 4:4**)
- And we ourselves have come to know and have believed the love that God has in our case. God is love, and he that remains in love remains in **union** with God and God remains in **union** with him. (**1 John 4:16**)

- **But we know that the Son of God has come, and he has given us intellectual capacity that we may gain the knowledge of the true one. And we are in union with the true one, by means of his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and life everlasting. (1 John 5:20)**
