[5] - References:

- Then Jesus turned and, getting a view of them following, he said to them; What are **you** looking for? They said to him; **Rabbi**, which means, when translated, Teacher. Where are you staying? (**John 1:38**)
- So in reply he said to them; Do **you** imagine that these Galileans were proved worse sinners than all other Galileans because they have suffered these things? (**Luke 13:2**)
- You must not bow down to them nor be induced to serve them, because I Yehowah your God am a God exacting exclusive devotion, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation, in the case of those who hate me. (**Exodus 20:5**)
- And **you** people will certainly say; Why is it that the son does not have to bear anything because of the error of the father? Now as regards the son, justice and righteousness he has executed, all the statutes of mine he has kept and he keeps doing them. He will positively keep living. (**Ezekiel 18:19**)
- In answer they said to him; You were altogether **born** in sins, and yet are you teaching us? And they threw him out! (**John 9:34**)
