**Isaiah 26:16** O Yehowah, during distress they have turned their attention to you, they have poured out a whisper of prayer when they had your disciplining.

- And the sons of Israel began to call to Yehowah for aid, saying; We **have** sinned against you, because we **have** left our God and we serve the Baals. (**Judges 10:10**)
- In the day of my **distress** I **have** searched for Yehowah himself. At night my very hand has been stretched **out** and does not grow numb, my soul has refused to be comforted. (**Psalms 77:2**)
- As often as he killed them, they also inquired for him, and they returned and looked for God. (**Psalms 78:34**)
- I shall go, I will return to my place until they bear their guilt, and they will certainly seek my face. When they are in sore straits, they will seek me. (**Hosea 5:15**)
- At this Yehowah's anger blazed against Israel, so that he sold them into the hand of Cushan-rishathaim the king of Mesopotamia, and the sons of Israel continued to serve Cushan-rishathaim eight years. (**Judges 3:8**)
- But **you have** entirely forgotten the exhortation which addresses **you** as sons; My son, do not belittle the discipline from Yehowah, neither give **out** when you are corrected by him. (**Hebrews 12:5**)
- For whom Yehowah loves he disciplines, in fact, he scourges every one whom he receives as a son. (**Hebrews 12:6**)
- It is for discipline **you** are enduring. God is dealing with **you** as with sons. For what son is he that a father does not discipline? (**Hebrews 12:7**)

- Before him I kept pouring **out** my concern, before him I continued to tell about my own **distress**. (**Psalms 142:2**)
- They are saying to a tree, You are my father, and to a stone, You yourself brought me to birth. But to me they **have turned** the back of the neck and not the face. And in the time of their calamity they will say, Do rise up and save us! (**Jeremiah 2:27**)
- None of his sins with which he has sinned will be remembered against him. Justice and righteousness are what he has carried on. He will positively keep living. (**Ezekiel 33:16**)
- And they proceeded to call **out** to Yehowah and to say; Ah, now, O Yehowah, may we, please, not perish because of the soul of this man! And do not put upon us innocent blood, since you yourself, O Yehowah, **have** done according to what you **have** delighted in! (**Jonah 1:14**)
- Then Jonah prayed to Yehowah his God from the inward parts of the fish (**Jonah 2:1**)
- And in that hour a great earthquake occurred, and a tenth of the city fell, and seven thousand persons were killed by the earthquake, and the rest became frightened and gave glory to the God of heaven. (**Revelation 11:13**)
