Yehowah … Qualities … Judgment - He will certainly remember the bloodguilty and will not forget the outcry of the afflicted (Psalms 9:12) [18] - References

Psalms 9:12... For, when looking for bloodshed, he will certainly remember those very ones, he is sure not to forget the outcry of the afflicted ones.

[18] - References

- At this he said; What have you done? Listen! Your brother's blood is crying out to me from the ground. (Genesis 4:10)
- Certainly the blood of Naboth and the blood of his sons I saw yesterday, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I shall certainly repay you in this tract of land, is the utterance of Yehowah. So now, lift him up, throw him into the tract of land according to the word of Yehowah. (2 Kings 9:26)
- And, besides that, YOUR blood of YOUR souls shall I ask back. From the hand of every living creature shall I ask it back, and from the hand of man, from the hand of each one who is his brother, shall I ask back the soul of man. (Genesis 9:5)
- Be glad, you nations, with his people, for he will avenge the blood of his servants, and he will pay back vengeance to his adversaries and will indeed make atonement for the ground of his people.

  (Deuteronomy 32:43)
- And also for the innocent blood that he had shed, so that he filled Jerusalem with innocent blood, and Yehowah did not consent to grant forgiveness. (2 Kings 24:4)
- For, look! Yehowah is coming forth from his place to call to account the error of the inhabitant of the land against him, and the land will certainly expose her bloodshed and will no longer cover over her killed ones. (Isaiah 26:21)
- So that the blood of all the prophets spilled from the founding of the world may be required from this generation. (Luke 11:50)

- And Yehowah added; Unquestionably I have seen the affliction of my people who are in Egypt, and I have heard their outcry as a result of those who drive them to work, because I well know the pains they suffer. (Exodus 3:7)
- From oppression and from violence he will redeem their soul, and their blood will be precious in his eyes. (Psalms 72:14)
- Certainly, then, shall not God cause justice to be done for his chosen ones who cry out to him day and night, even though he is long-suffering toward them? (Luke 18:7)
- But he continued on; Please, here I have taken upon myself to speak to Yehowah; Suppose twenty are found there. In turn he said; I shall not bring it to ruin on account of the twenty. (Genesis 18:31)
- Then Reuben answered them, saying; Did not I say to You; Do not sin against the child, but You did not listen? And now his blood, here it is certainly asked back. (Genesis 42:22)
