• With my soul I have desired you in the night, yes, with my spirit within me I keep looking for you, because, when there are judgments from you for the earth, **righteousness** is what the inhabitants of the **productive land will** certainly learn. (**Isaiah 26:9**)

• Before Yehowah, for he has come to **judge** the earth. He **will judge** the **productive land** with **righteousness** and the peoples with **uprightness**. (**Psalms 98:9**)

• Because he has set a day in which he purposes to **judge** the inhabited earth in **righteousness** by a man whom he has appointed, and he has furnished a guarantee to all men in that he has resurrected him from the dead. (**Acts of Apostles 17:31**)

• And the streambeds of the sea became visible, the foundations of the **productive land** became uncovered, at the rebuke of Yehowah, from the blast of the breath of his nostrils. (**2 Samuel 22:16**)

- Yehowah himself **will** pass sentence on the peoples. Judge me, O Yehowah, according to my **righteousness** and according to my integrity in me. (**Psalms 7:8**)
- And the streambeds of waters became visible, and the foundations of the **productive land** became uncovered from your rebuke, O Yehowah, from the blast of the breath of your nostrils. (**Psalms 18:15**)
- Let **national groups** rejoice and cry out joyfully, for you **will judge** the peoples with **uprightness**, and as for **national groups**, on the earth you **will** lead them. (**Psalms 67:4**)
- Yehowah is executing acts of **righteousness** and judicial decisions for all those being defrauded. (**Psalms 103:6**)
- For the sake of your name, O Yehowah, may you preserve me alive. In your **righteousness** may you bring forth my soul out of distress. (**Psalms 143:11**)
- Being glad at the **productive land** of his earth, and the things I was fond of were with the sons of men. (**Proverbs 8:31**)
- And I **will** make justice the measuring line and **righteousness** the leveling instrument, and the hail must sweep away the refuge of a lie, and the waters themselves **will** flood out the very place of concealment. (**Isaiah 28:17**)
- O Yehowah, according to all your acts of **righteousness**, please, may your anger and your rage turn back from your city Jerusalem, your holy mountain, for, because of our sins and because of the errors of our forefathers, Jerusalem and your people are an object of reproach to all those round about us. (**Daniel 9:16**)
