

JUDGEMENT - YEHOVAH HAS COME TO JUDGE THE EARTH

~ **Yehowah** ... **Qualities** ... **Judgment** - Yehowah has come to judge the earth with righteousness and his peoples with faithfulness' (**Psalms 96:13**) [22] - References

Psalms 96:13 Before Yehowah. For he has come, for he has come to judge the earth. He will judge the productive land with righteousness and the peoples with his faithfulness.

[22] - References

- Look! I am sending my messenger, and he must clear up a way before me. And suddenly there **will come** to His temple the true Lord, whom **you** people are seeking, and the messenger of the covenant in whom **you** are delighting. Look! He **will** certainly come, **Yehowah** of armies **has** said. (**Malachi 3:1**)
- Yes, the seventh one in line from Adam, Enoch, prophesied also regarding them, when he said; Look! **Yehowah** came with his holy myriads. (**Jude 1:14**)
- It is unthinkable of you that you are acting in this manner to put to death the righteous man with the wicked one so that it **has** to occur with the righteous man as it does with the wicked! It is unthinkable of you. Is the Judge of all the **earth** not going to do what is right? (**Genesis 18:25**)
- Now as he looked up he saw the rich dropping their gifts into the treasury chests. (**Luke 21:1**)
- Because he **has** set a day in which he purposes to **judge** the inhabited **earth** in **righteousness** by a man whom he **has** appointed, and he **has** furnished a guarantee to all men in that he **has** resurrected him from the dead. (**Acts of Apostles 17:31**)
- But by the same word the heavens and the **earth** that are now are stored up for fire and are being reserved to the day of judgment and of destruction of the ungodly men. (**2 Peter 3:7**)
- And he himself **will judge** the **productive land** in **righteousness**, he **will** judicially try national groups in uprightness. (**Psalms 9:8**)

- The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A God of **faithfulness**, with whom there is no injustice, Righteous and upright is he. (**Deuteronomy 32:4**)
- What, then, is the case? If some did not express faith, **will** their lack of faith perhaps make the **faithfulness** of God without effect? (**Romans 3:3**)
- For **Yehowah will judge** his people and he **will** feel regret over his servants, because he **will** see that support **has** disappeared and there is only a helpless and worthless one. (**Deuteronomy 32:36**)
- As for **Yehowah**, those contending against him **will** be terrified, Against them he **will** thunder in the heavens. **Yehowah** himself **will judge** the ends of the **earth**, that he may give strength to his king, that he may exalt the horn of his anointed one. (**1 Samuel 2:10**)
- At the same time let the trees of the forest break out joyfully on account of **Yehowah**, for he **has come** to **judge** the **earth**. (**1 Chronicles 16:33**)
- O **Yehowah** the God of Israel, you are righteous, because we have been left over as an escaped people as at this day. Here we are before you in our guiltiness, for it is impossible to stand before you on account of this. (**Ezra 9:15**)
- Judge me according to your **righteousness**, O **Yehowah** my God, and may they not rejoice over me. (**Psalms 35:24**)
- Do rise up, O God, do **judge** the **earth**, for you yourself should take possession of all the nations. (**Psalms 82:8**)
- And he **will** certainly render judgment among the nations and set matters straight respecting many **peoples**. And they **will** have to beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning shears. Nation **will** not lift up sword against nation, neither **will** they learn war anymore. (**Isaiah 2:4**)
- All **you** inhabitants of the **productive land** and **you** residents of the **earth**, **you will** see a sight just as when there is the raising up of a signal upon the mountains, and **you will** hear a sound just as when there is the blowing of a horn. (**Isaiah 18:3**)
- With my soul I have desired you in the night, yes, with my spirit within me I keep looking for you, because, when there are judgments from you for the **earth**, **righteousness** is what the inhabitants of the **productive land will** certainly learn. (**Isaiah 26:9**)

- Let the nations be aroused and **come** up to the low plain of Jehoshaphat, for there I shall sit in order to **judge** all the nations round about. (**Joel 3:12**)
- And he **will** certainly render judgment among many **peoples**, and set matters straight respecting mighty nations far away. And they **will** have to beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning shears. They **will** not lift up sword, nation against nation, neither **will** they learn war anymore. (**Micah 4:3**)
- And **you** people **will** certainly flee to the valley of my mountains, because the valley of the mountains **will** reach all the way to Azel. And **you will** have to flee, just as **you** fled because of the earthquake in the days of Uzziah the king of Judah. And **Yehowah** my God **will** certainly **come**, all the holy ones being with him. (**Zechariah 14:5**)
- Never may that happen! How, otherwise, **will** God **judge** the world? (**Romans 3:6**)
