- Because on me he has set his affection, I shall also provide him with escape. I shall protect him because he has come to know my **name**. (**Psalms 91:14**)
- The **name** of **Yehowah** is a strong tower. Into it the righteous runs and is given protection. (**Proverbs 18:10**)
- Therefore here I am causing them to know, at this one time I shall cause them to know my hand and my mightiness, and they **will** have to know that my **name** is **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 16:21**)
- O our God, **will** you not execute judgment upon them? For in us there is no power before this large crowd that is coming against us, and we ourselves do not know what we ought to do, but our eyes are toward you. (**2 Chronicles 20:12**)
- My eyes are constantly toward **Yehowah**, for he it is that brings my feet out of the net. (**Psalms 25:15**)
- From such a great thing as death he did rescue us and **will** rescue us, and our hope is in him that he **will** also rescue us further. (**2 Corinthians 1:10**)
- And they came to be helped against them, so that the Hagrites and all those who were with them were given into their hand, for it was to God that they called for aid in the war, and he let himself be entreated in their favor because they trusted in him. (**1 Chronicles 5:20**)
- And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father and serve him with a complete heart and with a delightful soul, for all hearts **Yehowah** is searching, and every inclination of the thoughts he is

discerning. If you search for him, he **will** let himself be found by you, but if you **leave** him, he **will** cast you off forever. (**1 Chronicles 28:9**)
