Psalms 105:9.. Which covenant he concluded with Abraham, and his sworn statement to Isaac,

^[17] - References

- And I will give my covenant between me and you, that I may multiply you very, very much. (**Genesis 17:2**)
- I shall surely bless you and I shall surely multiply your seed like the stars of the heavens and like the grains of sand that are on the seashore, and your seed will take possession of the gate of his enemies. (**Genesis 22:17**)
- Reside as an alien in this land, and I shall continue with you and bless you, because to you and to your seed I shall give all these lands, and I will carry out the **sworn statement** that I swore to **Abraham** your father. (**Genesis 26:3**)
- And you found his heart faithful before you, so there was a contracting of the covenant with him to give him the land of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Jebusites and the Girgashites, to give it to his seed, and you proceeded to carry out your words, because you are righteous. (**Nehemiah 9:8**)
- The oath that he swore to **Abraham** our forefather. (**Luke 1:73**)
- In this manner God, when he purposed to demonstrate more abundantly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of his counsel, stepped in with an oath. (**Hebrews 6:17**)
- As for me, look! My covenant is with you, and you will certainly become a father of a crowd of nations. (**Genesis 17:4**)
- To this God said; Sarah your wife is indeed bearing you a son, and you must call his name **Isaac**. And I will establish my covenant with him for a covenant to time indefinite to his seed after him. (**Genesis 17:19**)

- And to say; By myself I do swear, is the utterance of Yehowah, that by reason of the fact that you have done this thing and you have not withheld your son, your only one. (**Genesis 22:16**)
- And Yehowah proceeded to appear to him during that night and to say; I am the God of **Abraham** your father. Do not be afraid, because I am with you, and I will bless you and multiply your seed on account of **Abraham** my servant. (**Genesis 26:24**)
- But it was because of Yehowah's loving **YOU**, and because of his keeping the **sworn statement** that he had **sworn** to **YOUR** forefathers, that Yehowah brought **YOU** out with a strong hand, that he might redeem you from the house of slaves, from the hand of Pharaoh the king of Egypt. (**Deuteronomy 7:8**)
- For the purpose of establishing you today as his people and that he may prove himself your God, just as he has promised you and just as he has **sworn** to your forefathers **Abraham, Isaac** and Jacob. (**Deuteronomy 29:13**)
- Take a look at the covenant, for the dark places of the earth have become full of the abodes of violence. (**Psalms 74:20**)
- For the purpose of carrying out the oath that I swore to **YOUR** forefathers, to give them the land flowing with milk and honey, as in this day. And I proceeded to answer and say; Amen, O Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 11:5**)
- And I proceeded to bring them into the land that I had lifted up my hand in an oath to give them. When they got to see every exalted hill and every branchy tree, then they began sacrificing there their sacrifices and giving there their offensive offering, and presenting there their restful odors and pouring out there their drink offerings. (**Ezekiel 20:28**)
- You will give the trueness given to Jacob, the loving-kindness given to **Abraham**, which you swore to our forefathers from the days of long ago. (**Micah 7:20**)
- For when God made his promise to **Abraham**, since he could not swear by anyone greater, he swore by himself. (**Hebrews 6:13**)
