- And the Canaanites and all the inhabitants of the land will hear of it, and they will certainly surround us and cut our **name** off from the earth, and what will you do for your great name? (**Joshua 7:9**)
- For the **sake** of your **name**, O Yehowah, may you preserve me alive. In your righteousness may you bring forth my soul out of distress. (**Psalms 143:11**)
- But I acted for the **sake** of my own **name** that it might not be profaned before the eyes of the nations, before whose eyes I had brought them forth. (**Ezekiel 20:14**)
- But, in fact, for this cause I have kept you in existence, for the **sake** of showing you my power and in order to have my **name** declared in all the earth. (**Exodus 9:16**)
- For the Scripture says to Pharaoh: For this very cause I have let you remain, that in connection with you I may show my power, and that my **name** may be declared in all the earth. (**Romans 9:17**)
- Thus on that day Yehowah saved Israel from the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel got to see the Egyptians dead on the seashore. (**Exodus 14:30**)
- In order that all the peoples of the earth may know Yehowah's hand, that it is strong, in order, that **YOU** may indeed fear Yehowah **YOUR** God always. (**Joshua 4:24**)
- For Yehowah will not desert his people for the **sake** of his great **name**, because Yehowah has taken it upon himself to **make you** his people. (**1 Samuel 12:22**)

- But as for me, I shall sing of your strength, and in the morning I shall joyfully tell about your loving-kindness. For you have proved to be a secure height for me and a place to which to flee in the day of my distress. (**Psalms 59:16**)
- O you the hope of Israel, the Savior of him in the time of distress, why do you become like an alien resident in the land, and like a traveler that has turned aside to spend the night? (**Jeremiah 14:8**)
- Therefore say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Not for **YOUR sakes** am I doing it, O house of Israel, but for my holy **name**, which **YOU** have profaned among the nations where **YOU** have come in. (**Ezekiel 36:22**)
- And I will take **YOU** out of the nations and collect **YOU** together out of all the lands and bring **YOU** in upon **YOUR** soil. (**Ezekiel 36:24**)
