**Psalms 74:13**.. You yourself stirred up the sea with your own strength, you broke the heads of the sea monsters in the waters.

[13] - References

- Moses now stretched his hand out over the **sea**, and Yehowah began making the **sea** go back by a strong east wind all night long and converting the **sea** basin into dry ground, and the **waters** were being split apart. (**Exodus 14:21**)
- And the **sea** you split before them, so that they crossed over through the midst of the **sea** on the dry land, and their pursuers you hurled into the depths like a stone in the strong **waters**. (**Nehemiah 9:11**)
- He split the **sea**, that he might let them pass over, and he caused the **waters** to stand like a dam. (**Psalms 78:13**)
- Accordingly he rebuked the Red Sea, and it was gradually dried up, and he went walking them through the watery deep as through the wilderness. (**Psalms 106:9**)
- And the **waters** kept coming back. Finally they covered the war chariots and the cavalrymen belonging to all of Pharaoh's military forces and who had gone into the **sea** after them. Not so much as one among them was let remain. (**Exodus 14:28**)
- And who shook off Pharaoh and his military force into the Red Sea, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (**Psalms 136:15**)
- Awake, awake, clothe yourself with **strength**, O arm of Yehowah! Awake as in the days of long ago, as during the generations of times long past. Are you not the one that **broke** Rahab to pieces, that pierced the **sea** monster? (**Isaiah 51:9**)
- Speak, and you must say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Pharaoh, king of Egypt,

the great **sea** monster lying stretched out in the midst of his Nile canals, that has said; My Nile River belongs to me, and I, I have made it for myself. (**Ezekiel 29:3**)

· Son of man, lift up a dirge concerning Pharaoh the king of Egypt, and you must say to him; As a maned young lion of nations you have been silenced. And you have been like the marine monster in the **seas**, and you kept gushing in your rivers and kept muddying the **waters** with your feet and fouling their rivers. (**Ezekiel 32:2**)

· By his power he has stirred up the **sea**, and by his understanding he has broken the stormer to pieces. (**Job 26:12**)

· By his wind he has polished up heaven itself, this hand has pierced the gliding serpent. (**Job 26:13**)

· Praise Yehowah from the earth, **you sea monsters** and all **you** watery deeps. (**Psalms 148:7**)

· In that day Yehowah, with his hard and great and strong sword, will turn his attention to Leviathan, the gliding serpent, even to Leviathan, the crooked serpent, and he will certainly kill the **sea** monster that is in the **sea**. (**Isaiah 27:1**)
