Psalms 44:3· For it was not by their own sword that they took possession of the land, and their own arm was not what brought them salvation. For it was your right hand and your arm and the light of your face, because you took pleasure in them.

[30] - References

- To drive away nations greater and mightier than you from before you, so as to bring you in, to give you their **land** as an inheritance as at this day. (**Deuteronomy 4:38**)
- And you do say in your heart; My **own** power and the full might of my **own hand** have made this wealth for me. (**Deuteronomy 8:17**)
- For Yehowah will not desert his people for the sake of his great name, because Yehowah has taken it upon himself to make **YOU** his people. (**1 Samuel 12:22**)
- The One making His beautiful **arm** go at the **right hand** of Moses, the One splitting the waters from before them in order to make an indefinitely lasting name for his **own** self. (**Isaiah 63:12**)
- But it was because of Yehowah's loving **YOU**, and because of his keeping the sworn statement that he had sworn to **YOUR** forefathers, that Yehowah **brought YOU** out with a strong **hand**, that he might redeem you from the house of slaves, from the **hand** of Pharaoh the king of Egypt. (**Deuteronomy 7:8**)
- From Aroer, which is by the bank of the torrent valley of Arnon, and the city that is in the torrent valley, as far as Gilead, there proved to be no town that was too high up for us. Yehowah our God abandoned them all to us. (**Deuteronomy 2:36**)
- O Sovereign Lord Yehowah, you yourself have started to make your servant see your greatness and your strong **arm**, for who is a god

in the heavens or on the earth that does deeds like yours and mighty performances like yours? (**Deuteronomy 3:24**)

- Then Yehowah said to Joshua; Do not be afraid or be terrified. Take with you all the people of war and get up, go up to Ai. See, I have given into your **hand** the king of Ai and his people and his city and his **land**. (**Joshua 8:1**)

- And Yehowah went throwing them into confusion before Israel, and they began to slay them with a great slaughter at Gibeon and went pursuing them by way of the ascent of Bethhoron and slaying them as far as Azekah and Makkedah. (**Joshua 10:10**)

- So Yehowah gave Israel all the **land** that he had sworn to give to their forefathers, and they proceeded to take **possession** of it and to dwell in it. (**Joshua 21:43**)

- And as for **YOU**, **YOU** have seen all that Yehowah **YOUR** God did to all these nations on **YOUR** account, because Yehowah **YOUR** God was the one who was fighting for **YOU**. (**Joshua 23:3**)

- So I sent the feeling of dejection ahead of **YOU**, and it gradually drove them out before **YOU**, two kings of the Amorites, not with your **sword** and not with your bow. (**Joshua 24:12**)

- Meantime the house of Joseph itself also went up against Bethel, and Yehowah was with them. (**Judges 1:22**)

- The torrent of Kishon washed them away, the torrent of ancient days, the torrent of Kishon. You went treading down strength, O my soul. (**Judges 5:21**)

- In turn he said to him; Excuse me, Yehowah. With **what** shall I save Israel? Look! My thousand is the least in Manasseh, and I am the smallest in my father's house. (**Judges 6:15**)

- So Jephthah said to the older men of Gilead; If **YOU** are bringing me back to fight against the sons of Ammon, and Yehowah does abandon them to me, I, for my part, shall become **YOUR** head! (**Judges 11:9**)

- Now he became very thirsty, and he began to call on Yehowah and say; It was you that gave this great **salvation** into the **hand** of your servant, and now shall I die of thirst and must I fall into the **hand** of the uncircumcised? (**Judges 15:18**)

- Then Samuel **took** a stone and set it between Mizpah and Jeshanah and began to call its name Ebenezer. Accordingly he said; Till now Yehowah has helped us. (**1 Samuel 7:12**)
- As soon as Jacob had come into Egypt and **YOUR** forefathers began calling to Yehowah for aid, Yehowah proceeded to send Moses and Aaron, that they might lead **YOUR** forefathers out from Egypt and cause them to dwell in this place. (**1 Samuel 12:8**)
- And it happened on the day of battle that not a **sword** or a spear was found in the **hand** of any of the people that were with Saul and Jonathan, but there could be found one belonging to Saul and to Jonathan his son. (**1 Samuel 13:22**)
- And Jonathan kept going up on his **hands** and his feet, and his armor-bearer after him, and they began to fall before Jonathan, and his armor-bearer was putting them to death behind him. (**1 Samuel 14:13**)
- But David said; **You** must not do that way, my brothers, with **what** Yehowah has given us, in that he safeguarded us and gave the marauder band that came against us into our **hand**. (**1 Samuel 30:23**)
- And you will gird me with vital energy for the battle, you will make those rising against me collapse under me. (**2 Samuel 22:40**)
- But he **took** his stand in the middle of the tract and delivered it and kept striking down the Philistines, so that Yehowah performed a great **salvation**. (**2 Samuel 23:12**)
- And they came to be helped against them, so that the Hagrites and all those who were with them were given into their **hand**, for it was to God that they called for aid in the war, and he let himself be entreated in their favor because they trusted in him. (**1 Chronicles 5:20**)
- And he proceeded to bring them to his holy territory, this mountainous region that his **right hand** acquired. (**Psalms 78:54**)
- An **arm** with mightiness is yours, your **hand** is strong, your **right hand** is exalted. (**Psalms 89:13**)
- And who gave their **land** as an inheritance, an inheritance to Israel his people. (**Psalms 135:12**)
- Plan out a scheme, and it will be broken up! Speak any word, and it will not stand, for God is with us! (**Isaiah 8:10**)
