Psalms 81:12.. And so I let them go in the stubbornness of their heart, they went walking in their own counsels.

- But they did not listen or incline their ear, but they kept **walking** each one in the **stubbornness** of their bad **heart**, and so I brought upon them all the words of this covenant that I commanded them to do, but that they did not do. (**Jeremiah 11:8**)
- And they said; It is hopeless! For after our **own** thoughts we shall walk, and we are going to carry out each one the **stubbornness** of his bad **heart**. (**Jeremiah 18:12**)
- Obstinate men and uncircumcised in **hearts** and ears, **YOU** are always resisting the Holy Spirit, as **YOUR** forefathers did, so **YOU** do. (**Acts of Apostles 7:51**)
- Therefore God, in keeping with the desires of their **hearts**, gave them up to uncleanness, that their bodies might be dishonored among them. (**Romans 1:24**)
- But they did not listen, neither did they incline their ear, but they **went walking** in the **counsels** in the **stubbornness** of their bad **heart**, so that they became backward in direction and not forward. (**Jeremiah 7:24**)
- And the statutes of Omri and all the work of the house of Ahab are observed, and **YOU** people walk in their **counsels**, to the end that I may make you an object of astonishment and her inhabitants something to be whistled at, and the reproach of peoples **YOU** men will bear. (**Micah 6:16**)
- But Yehowah's angel said to Balaam; Go with the men, and nothing but the word that I shall speak to you is what you may speak. And Balaam continued going with the princes of Balak. (**Numbers 22:35**)

- Then Yehowah said to Samuel; Listen to the voice of the people as respects all that they say to you, for it is not you whom they have rejected, but it is I whom they have rejected from being king over them. (**1 Samuel 8:7**)
- And they should not become like their forefathers, a generation stubborn and rebellious, a generation who had not prepared their **heart** and whose spirit was not trustworthy with God. (**Psalms 78:8**)
- He will be the one to die because there is no discipline, and because in the abundance of his foolishness he goes astray. (**Proverbs 5:23**)
- They have not come to know, nor do they understand, because their eyes have been besmeared so as not to see, their **heart** so as to have no insight. (**Isaiah 44:18**)
- The one slaughtering the bull is as one striking down a man. The one sacrificing the sheep is as one breaking the neck of a dog. The one offering up a gift, the blood of a pig! The one presenting a memorial of frankincense is as one saying a blessing with uncanny words. They are also the ones that have chosen their **own** ways, and in their disgusting things their very soul has taken a delight. (**Isaiah 66:3**)
- But this very people has come to have a stubborn and rebellious **heart**, they have turned aside and keep **walking** in their course. (**Jeremiah 5:23**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Woe to the stupid prophets, who are **walking** after their **own** spirit, when there is nothing that they have seen! (**Ezekiel 13:3**)
- And I myself also let them have regulations that were not good and judicial decisions by which they could not keep living. (**Ezekiel 20:25**)
- And **you**, O house of Israel, this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Go serve each one of **you** his **own** dungy idols. And afterward if **you** are not listening to me, then my holy name **you** will no more profane by **your** gifts and by **your** dungy idols. (**Ezekiel 20:39**)
- For, like a stubborn cow, Israel has become stubborn. Is it now that Yehowah will shepherd them like a young ram in a roomy place? (**Hosea 4:16**)
- So God turned and handed them over to render sacred service to the arm: It was not to me that **you** offered victims and sacrifices for

forty years in the wilderness, was it, O house of Israel? (**Acts of Apostles 7:42**)
