~ **Yehowah** ... **Qualities** ... **Redeemer From Death** - From the hand of Sheol, **grave**, even from death I shall redeem them, Where then are your stings O death, where is your destructiveness O Sheol · (**Hosea 13:14**) [13] - References

Hosea 13:14· From the hand of Sheol I shall redeem them, from death I shall recover them. Where are your stings, O Death? Where is your destructiveness, O Sheol? Compassion itself will be concealed from my eyes.

[13] - References

- O Yehowah, you have brought up my soul from **Sheol** itself, you have kept me alive, that I should not go down into the pit. (**Psalms 30:3**)
- However, God himself **will redeem** my soul from the **hand of Sheol**, for he **will** receive me. (**Psalms 49:15**)
- Do come near to my soul, reclaim it, on account of my enemies **redeem** me. (**Psalms 69:18**)
- He **will** actually swallow up **death** forever, and the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **will** certainly wipe the tears from all faces. And the reproach of his people he **will** take away from all the earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken it. (**Isaiah 25:8**)
- Your dead ones **will** live. A corpse of mine, they **will** rise up. Awake and cry out joyfully, **you** residents in the dust! For your dew is as the dew of mallows, and the earth itself **will** let even those impotent in **death** drop in birth. (**Isaiah 26:19**)
- Death, where is your victory? **Death**, where is your sting? (**1 Corinthians 15:55**)
- And the sea gave up those dead in it, and **death** and Hades gave up those dead in them, and they were judged individually according to their deeds. (**Revelation 20:13**)

- And, besides, the Excellency of Israel **will** not prove false, and He **will** not feel regrets, for He is not an earthling man so as to feel regrets. (**1 Samuel 15:29**)
- You yourself have deserted me, is the utterance of Yehowah. Backwards is the way you keep walking. And I shall stretch out my **hand** against you and bring you to ruin. I have got tired of feeling regret. (**Jeremiah 15:6**)
- However, he said; My son **will** not go down with **YOU** men, because his brother is dead and he has been left by himself. If a fatal accident should befall him on the way on which **YOU** would go, then **YOU** would certainly bring down my gray hairs with grief to **Sheol**. (**Genesis 42:38**)
- If **YOU** were to take this one also out of my sight and a fatal accident were to befall him, **YOU** would certainly bring down my gray hairs with calamity to Sheol. (**Genesis 44:29**)
- And the prayer of faith **will** make the indisposed one well, and Yehowah **will** raise him up. Also, if he has committed sins, it **will** be forgiven him. (**James 5:15**)
- And **death** and Hades were hurled into the lake of fire. This means the second **death**, the lake of fire. (**Revelation 20:14**)
