Exodus 33:20· And he added; **You are not able to see my face, because no man may see me and yet live.**

· Then **you** said; Here Yehowah our God has shown us his glory and his greatness, and we have heard his voice out of the middle of the fire. This day we have seen that God may speak with **man** and he may actually keep living. (**Deuteronomy 5:24**)

· God is a Spirit, and those worshiping him must worship with spirit and truth. (**John 4:24**)

· In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. (**Genesis 1:1**)

· After that I must take my palm away, and you will indeed **see** my back. But my **face** may not be seen. (**Exodus 33:23**)

· I shall **see** him, but not now, I shall behold him, but not near. A star will certainly step forth out of Jacob, and a scepter will indeed rise out of Israel. And he will certainly break apart the temples of Moab's head and the cranium of all the sons of tumult of war. (**Numbers 24:17**)

· But there has never yet risen up a prophet in Israel like Moses, whom Yehowah knew **face** to **face**. (**Deuteronomy 34:10**)

· Consequently Manoah said to his wife; We shall positively die, because it is God that we have seen. (**Judges 13:22**)

· In the year that King Uzziah died I, however, got to **see** Yehowah, sitting on a throne lofty and lifted up, and his skirts were filling the temple. (**Isaiah 6:1**)

· And I proceeded to say; Woe to me! For I am as good as brought to silence, because a **man** unclean in lips I am, and in among a people unclean in lips I am dwelling, for my eyes have seen the King, Yehowah of armies, himself! (**Isaiah 6:5**)

- No **man** has seen God at any time, the only-begotten god who is in the bosom position with the Father is the one that has explained him. (**John 1:18**)
