

**REVEALS SELF TO MOSES - YEHOWAH A GOD GRACIOUS AND MERCIFUL**

**Exodus 34:6** ... **And Yehowah went passing by before his face and declaring; Yehowah, Yehowah, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abundant in loving-kindness and truth,**

• For when **YOU** return to **Yehowah**, **YOUR** brothers and **YOUR** sons will be objects of mercy **before** those holding them captive, and be allowed to return to this land, for **Yehowah YOUR God** is **gracious** and **merciful**, and he will not turn away the **face** from **YOU** if **YOU** return to him. **(2 Chronicles 30:9)**

• So they refused to listen, and they did not remember your wonderful acts that you performed with them, but they hardened their neck and appointed a head to return to their servitude in Egypt. But you are a **God** of acts of forgiveness, **gracious** and **merciful**, **slow to anger** and **abundant in loving-kindness**, and you did not leave them. **(Nehemiah 9:17)**

• And rip apart **YOUR** hearts, and not **YOUR** garments, and come back to **Yehowah YOUR God**, for he is **gracious** and **merciful**, **slow to anger** and **abundant in loving-kindness**, and he will certainly feel regret on account of the calamity. **(Joel 2:13)**

• Continue becoming **merciful**, just as **YOUR** Father is **merciful**. **(Luke 6:36)**

• For I shall be **merciful** to their unrighteous deeds, and I shall by no means call their sins to mind anymore. **(Hebrews 8:12)**

• For it is his only covering. It is his mantle for his skin. In what will he lie down? And it must occur that he will cry out to me, and I shall certainly hear, because I am **gracious**. **(Exodus 22:27)**

• And in your **abundant** mercy you did not make an extermination of them or leave them, for you are a **God gracious** and **merciful**. **(Nehemiah 9:31)**

- But you, O **Yehowah**, are a **God merciful** and **gracious, slow to anger** and **abundant in loving-kindness** and trueness. (**Psalms 86:15**)
- Hence he prayed to **Yehowah** and said; Ah, now, O **Yehowah**, was not this an affair of mine, while I happened to be on my own ground? That is why I **went** ahead and ran away to Tarshish, for I knew that you are a **God gracious** and **merciful, slow to anger** and **abundant in loving-kindness**, and feeling regret over the calamity. (**Jonah 4:2**)
- **Yehowah, slow to anger** and **abundant in loving-kindness**, pardoning error and transgression, but by no means will he give exemption from punishment, bringing punishment for the error of the fathers upon sons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation. (**Numbers 14:18**)
- **Yehowah** is **slow to anger** and great in power, and by no means will **Yehowah** hold back from punishing. In destructive wind and in storm is his way, and the cloud mass is the powder of his feet. (**Nahum 1:3**)
- If, now, **God**, although having the will to demonstrate his wrath and to make his power known, tolerated with much long-suffering vessels of wrath made fit for destruction. (**Romans 9:22**)
- **Yehowah** is not **slow** respecting his promise, as some people consider slowness, but he is patient with **you** because he does not desire any to be destroyed but desires all to attain to repentance. (**2 Peter 3:9**)
- From far away **Yehowah** himself appeared to me, saying; And with a love to time indefinite I have loved you. That is why I have drawn you with **loving-kindness**. (**Jeremiah 31:3**)
- It is the acts of **loving-kindness** of **Yehowah** that we have not come to our finish, because his mercies will certainly not come to an end. (**Lamentations 3:22**)
- Who is a **God** like you, one pardoning error and **passing** over transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? He will certainly not hold onto his **anger** forever, for he is delighting in **loving-kindness**. (**Micah 7:18**)
- Into your hand I entrust my spirit. You have redeemed me, O **Yehowah** the **God of truth**. (**Psalms 31:5**)

- Now we know that the judgment of **God** is, in accord with **truth**, against those who practice such things. (**Romans 2:2**)
- But he continued; May **Yehowah**, please, not grow hot with **anger**, but let me go on speaking; Suppose thirty are found there. In turn he said; I shall not do it if I find thirty there. (**Genesis 18:30**)
- But he said; I myself shall cause all my goodness to pass **before** your **face**, and I will declare the name of **Yehowah** **before** you, and I will favor the one whom I may favor, and I will show mercy to the one to whom I may show mercy. (**Exodus 33:19**)
- O Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**, you yourself have started to make your servant see your greatness and your strong arm, for who is a god in the heavens or on the earth that does deeds like yours and mighty performances like yours? (**Deuteronomy 3:24**)
- For **Yehowah** your **God** is a **merciful God**. He will not desert you or bring you to ruin or forget the covenant of your forefathers that he swore to them. (**Deuteronomy 4:31**)
- Finally Naomi said to both of her daughters-in-law; Go, return, each one to the house of her mother. May **Yehowah** exercise **loving-kindness** toward **you**, just as **you** have exercised it toward the men now dead and toward me. (**Ruth 1:8**)
- At that Naomi said to her daughter-in-law; Blessed be he of **Yehowah**, who has not left his **loving-kindness** toward the living and the dead. And Naomi **went** on to say to her; The man is related to us. He is one of our repurchasers. (**Ruth 2:20**)
- David now said to Nathan; I have sinned against Yehowah. At this Nathan said to David; **Yehowah**, in turn, does let your sin pass by. You will not die. (**2 Samuel 12:13**)
- And after the quaking there was a fire. **Yehowah** was not in the fire. And after the fire there was a calm, low voice. (**1 Kings 19:12**)
- So David said to Gad; It is very distressing to me. Please, let me fall into the hand of **Yehowah**, for very many are his mercies, but into the hand of man do not let me fall. (**1 Chronicles 21:13**)
- And it came about that as soon as the trumpeters and the singers were as one in causing one sound to be heard in praising and thanking **Yehowah**, and as soon as they lifted up the sound with the trumpets and with the cymbals and with the instruments of song and with praising **Yehowah**, for he is good, for to time indefinite is his loving-

kindness, the house itself was filled with a cloud, the very house of **Yehowah**. (2 Chronicles 5:13)

- Further, he took counsel with the people and stationed singers to **Yehowah** and those offering praise in holy adornment as they **went** out ahead of the armed men, and saying; **GIVE** praise to **Yehowah**, for to time indefinite is his loving-kindness. (2 Chronicles 20:21)

- And upon Mount Sinai you came down and spoke with them out of heaven and **went** on to give them upright judicial decisions and Laws of **truth**, good regulations and commandments. (Nehemiah 9:13)

- For this you gave them into the hand of their adversaries, who kept causing them distress, but in the time of their distress they would cry out to you, and you yourself would hear from the very heavens, and in accord with your **abundant** mercy you would give them saviors who would save them out of the hand of their adversaries. (Nehemiah 9:27)

- Remember your mercies, O **Yehowah**, and your loving-kindnesses, for they are from time indefinite. (Psalms 25:6)

- But he was **merciful**, he would cover the error and not bring ruin. And many times he made his **anger** turn back, and he would not rouse up all his rage. (Psalms 78:38)

- Do not remember against us the errors of ancestors. Hurry! Let your mercies confront us, for we have become greatly impoverished. (Psalms 79:8)

- Righteousness and judgment are the established place of your throne, **loving-kindness** and trueness themselves come in **before** your **face**. (Psalms 89:14)

- For **Yehowah** is good, his **loving-kindness** is to time indefinite, and his faithfulness to generation after generation. (Psalms 100:5)

- **Yehowah** is **merciful** and **gracious**, **slow** to **anger** and **abundant** in **loving-kindness**. (Psalms 103:8)

- And he would remember concerning them his covenant, and he would feel regret according to the abundance of his grand **loving-kindness**. (Psalms 106:45)

- A memorial he has made for his wonderful works. **Yehowah** is **gracious** and **merciful**. (Psalms 111:4)

- **Yehowah** is **gracious** and righteous, and our **God** is One showing mercy. (Psalms 116:5)

- May your **loving-kindness** serve, please, to comfort me, according to your saying to your servant. (**Psalms 119:76**)
- Your righteousness is a righteousness to time indefinite, and your Law is **truth**. (**Psalms 119:142**)
- **Yehowah** is **gracious** and **merciful**, **slow** to **anger** and great in **loving-kindness**. (**Psalms 145:8**)
- And therefore **Yehowah** will keep in expectation of showing **you** favor, and therefore he will rise up to show **you** mercy. For **Yehowah** is a **God** of judgment. Happy are all those keeping in expectation of him. (**Isaiah 30:18**)
- Let the wicked man leave his way, and the harmful man his thoughts, and let him return to **Yehowah**, who will have mercy upon him, and to our **God**, for he will forgive in a large way. (**Isaiah 55:7**)
- But let the one bragging about himself brag about himself because of this very thing, the having of insight and the having of knowledge of me, that I am **Yehowah**, the One exercising **loving-kindness**, justice and righteousness in the earth, for in these things I do take delight, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 9:24**)
- And I shall give to **you** mercies, and he will certainly have mercy upon **you** and return **you** to **your** own soil. (**Jeremiah 42:12**)
- And I began to pray to **Yehowah** my **God** and to make confession and to say; Ah **Yehowah** the true **God**, the great One and the fear-inspiring One, keeping the covenant and the **loving-kindness** to those loving him and to those keeping his commandments. (**Daniel 9:4**)
- To **Yehowah** our **God** belong the mercies and the acts of forgiveness, for we have rebelled against him. (**Daniel 9:9**)
- Or do you despise the riches of his kindness and forbearance and long-suffering, because you do not know that the kindly quality of **God** is trying to lead you to repentance? (**Romans 2:4**)
- Blessed be the **God** and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of tender mercies and the **God** of all comfort. (**2 Corinthians 1:3**)
- May the Lord grant him to find mercy from **Yehowah** in that day. And all the services he rendered in Ephesus you know well enough. (**2 Timothy 1:18**)
