- Further, he put in my mouth a new song, praise to our God. Many will see it and will fear, and they will trust in **Yehowah**. (**Psalms 40:3**)
- Happy is the able-bodied man that has put **Yehowah** as his trust and that has not turned his face to defiant **people**, nor to those falling away to lies. (**Psalms 40:4**)
- Many things you yourself have done, O **Yehowah** my God, even your wonderful works and your **thoughts** toward us, there is none to be compared to you. Were I inclined to tell and speak of them, they have become more numerous than I can recount. (**Psalms 40:5**)
- All this I have tested with wisdom. I said; I will become wise. But it was far from me. (**Ecclesiastes 7:23**)
- What has come to be is far off and exceedingly deep. Who can find it out. (**Ecclesiastes 7:24**)
- For who has come to know Yehowah's mind, or who has become his counselor? (**Romans 11:34**)
- There exists a way that is upright before a man, but the **ways** of death are the end of it afterward. (**Proverbs 16:25**)
- Every way of a man is upright in his own eyes, but **Yehowah** is making an estimate of hearts. (**Proverbs 21:2**)
- Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, am praising and exalting and glorifying the King of the heavens, because all his works are truth and his **ways** are justice, and because those who are walking in pride he is able to humiliate. (**Daniel 4:37**)

· Who is wise, that he may understand these things? Discreet, that he may know them? For the ways of Yehowah are upright, and the righteous are the ones who will walk in them, but the transgressors are the ones who will stumble in them. (Hosea 14:9)

· And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father and serve him with a complete heart and with a delightful soul, for all hearts Yehowah is searching, and every inclination of the thoughts he is discerning. If you search for him, he will let himself be found by you, but if you leave him, he will cast you off forever. (1 Chronicles 28:9)

· The things concealed belong to Yehowah our God, but the things revealed belong to us and to our sons to time indefinite, that we may carry out all the words of this Law. (Deuteronomy 29:29)

· But Yehowah said to Samuel; Do not look at his appearance and at the height of his stature, for I have rejected him. For not the way man sees is the way God sees, because mere man sees what appears to the eyes, but as for Yehowah, he sees what the heart is. (1 Samuel 16:7)

· At this Naaman grew indignant and began to go away and say; Here I had said to myself, To me he will come out all the way and will certainly stand and call upon the name of Yehowah his God and move his hand to and fro over the place and actually give the leper recovery. (2 Kings 5:11)

· To time indefinite the very counsel of Yehowah will stand, the thoughts of his heart are to one generation after another generation. (Psalms 33:11)

· Many things you yourself have done, O Yehowah my God, even your wonderful works and your thoughts toward us, there is none to be compared to you. Were I inclined to tell and speak of them, they have become more numerous than I can recount. (Psalms 40:5)

· I shall not express my burning anger. I shall not bring Ephraim to ruin again, for I am God and not man, the Holy One in the midst of you, and I shall not come in excitement. (Hosea 11:9)

· But as for them, they have not come to know the thoughts of Yehowah, and they have not come to understand his counsel, because he will certainly collect them together like a row of newly cut grain to the threshing floor. (Micah 4:12)
