

## SANCTUARY - SHOWBREAD

~ **Yehowah** ... **Sanctuary** ... **Showbread** - You must place the showbread on the table before me constantly' (**Exodus 25:30**) <sup>[11]</sup> -

**Exodus 25:30** And you must put the showbread upon the table before me constantly.

[11] - References

- And you must take fine flour and bake it up into twelve ring-shaped cakes. Two tenths of an ephah should go to each ring-shaped cake. (**Leviticus 24:5**)
- At that the priest gave him what was holy, because there happened to be no bread there but the **showbread** that had been removed from **before** Yehowah so as to place fresh bread there on the day of its being taken away. (**1 Samuel 21:6**)
- And some of the sons of the Kohathites, their brothers, were in charge of the layer bread, to prepare it Sabbath by Sabbath. (**1 Chronicles 9:32**)
- And they are making burnt offerings smoke to Yehowah morning by morning and evening by evening and also perfumed incense, and the layers of bread are upon the **table** of pure gold, and there are the golden lampstand and its lamps to light up evening by evening, because we are keeping the obligation to Yehowah our God, but **you** yourselves have left him. (**2 Chronicles 13:11**)
- How he entered into the house of God and they ate the loaves of presentation, something that it was not Lawful for him to eat, nor for those with him, but for the priests only? (**Matthew 12:4**)
- The **table** and its poles and all its utensils and the **showbread**. (**Exodus 35:13**)
- And he arranged the row of bread upon it **before** Yehowah, just as Yehowah had commanded Moses. (**Exodus 40:23**)

- **But the priest answered David and said; There is no ordinary bread under my hand, but there is holy bread, provided that the young men have at least kept themselves from womankind. (1 Samuel 21:4)**
- **Here I am building a house to the name of Yehowah my God to sanctify it to him, to burn perfumed incense **before** him, with the constant layer bread and burnt offerings in the morning and in the evening, on the Sabbaths and on the new moons and at the festival seasons of Yehowah our God. To time indefinite this will be upon Israel. (2 Chronicles 2:4)**
- **And the dining room the front of which is toward the north is for the priests who are taking care of the obligation of the altar. They are the sons of Zadok, who, from the sons of Levi, are approaching Yehowah to minister to him. (Ezekiel 40:46)**
- **How he entered into the house of God, in the account about Abiathar the chief priest, and ate the loaves of presentation, which it is not Lawful for anybody to eat except the priests, and he gave some also to the men who were with him? (Mark 2:26)**
