Exodus 7:5· **And the Egyptians will certainly know that I am Yehowah when I stretch out my hand against Egypt, and I shall indeed bring the sons of Israel out from their midst.**

- And I, even I, well **know** that the king of **Egypt will** not give **you** permission to go except by a strong **hand**. (Exodus 3:19)
- Hence the magic-practicing priests said to Pharaoh; It is the finger of God! But Pharaoh's heart continued to be obstinate, and he did not listen to them, just as **Yehowah** had spoken. (Exodus 8:19)
- And on that day I shall **certainly** make the land of Goshen upon which my people are standing distinct, that no gadfly may exist there, in order, that you may **know** that I **am Yehowah** in the **midst** of the earth. (Exodus 8:22)
- So I shall indeed let Pharaoh's heart become obstinate, and he **will certainly** chase after them and I shall get glory for myself by means of Pharaoh and all his military forces, and the Egyptians **will certainly know** that I **am Yehowah**. Accordingly they did just that. (Exodus 14:4)
- That people may **know** that you, whose name is **Yehowah**, you alone are the Most High over all the earth. (Psalms 83:18)
- And I shall have to **stretch out** my **hand** and strike **Egypt** with all my wonderful acts that I shall do in the **midst** of it, and after that he **will send you out**. (Exodus 3:20)
- But Pharaoh said; Who is **Yehowah**, so that I should obey his voice to send **Israel** away? I do not **know Yehowah** at all and, what is more, I **am** not going to send **Israel** away. (Exodus 5:2)
- Therefore say to the **sons of Israel**, I **am Yehowah**, and I shall **certainly bring you out** from under the burdens of the Egyptians and

deliver **you** from their slavery, and I shall indeed reclaim **you** with an outstretched arm and with great judgments. (**Exodus 6:6**)

· And I shall **certainly** take **you** to me as a people, and I shall indeed prove to be God to **you**, and **you will certainly know** that I **am Yehowah** **YOUR** God who is bringing **you out** from under the burdens of **Egypt**. (**Exodus 6:7**)

· This is what **Yehowah** has said; By this you **will know** that I **am Yehowah**. Here I **am** striking with the rod that is in my **hand** upon the water that is in the Nile River, and it **will certainly** turn into blood. (**Exodus 7:17**)

· Woe to us! Who **will** save us from the **hand** of this majestic God? This is the God that was the smiter of **Egypt** with every sort of slaughter in the wilderness. (**1 Samuel 4:8**)

· Then the man of the true God approached and said to the king of **Israel**, yes, he went on to say; This is what **Yehowah** has said; For the reason that the Syrians have said; Yehowah is a God of mountains, and he is not a God of low plains, I shall have to give all this great crowd into your **hand**, and **you** men **will certainly know** that I **am Yehowah**. (**1 Kings 20:28**)

· And I **will** strengthen the arms of the king of Babylon, and the very arms of Pharaoh **will** fall, and they **will** have to **know** that I **am Yehowah** when I give my sword into the **hand** of the king of Babylon and he actually extends it **out against** the land of **Egypt**. (**Ezekiel 30:25**)

· When I make the land of **Egypt** a desolate waste and the land is desolated of its fullness, when I strike down all the inhabitants in it, they **will** also have to **know** that I **am Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 32:15**)
