2 Chronicles 7:20'' **I will also uproot them from off my ground that I have given them, and this house that I have sanctified for my name, I shall throw away from before my face, and I shall make it a proverbial saying and a taunt among all the peoples.**

- I do take as witnesses against **you** today the heavens and the earth, that **you** will positively perish in a hurry from off the land to which **you** are crossing the Jordan to take possession of it. **You** will not lengthen **YOUR** days on it, because **you** will positively be annihilated. (Deuteronomy 4:26)
- Consequently Yehowah rejected all the seed of Israel and kept afflicting them and giving them into the hand of pillagers, until he had cast them **away** from **before** him. (2 Kings 17:20)
- I will also cut Israel off from upon the surface of the **ground** that I **have given** to them, and the **house** that I **have sanctified** to my **name** I shall **throw away** from **before** me, and Israel will indeed become a **proverbial saying** and a **taunt among** all the **peoples**. (1 Kings 9:7)
- And he proceeded to burn the **house** of Yehowah and the king's **house** and all the **houses** of Jerusalem, and the **house** of every great man he burned with fire. (2 Kings 25:9)
- And you must become an object of astonishment, a **proverbial saying** and a **taunt among** all the **peoples** to whom Yehowah will lead you **away**. (Deuteronomy 28:37)
- I will also give them over for quaking, for calamity, in all the kingdoms of the earth, for reproach and for a **proverbial saying**, for a **taunt** and for a malediction, in all the places to which I shall disperse them. (Jeremiah 24:9)

- You set us as a **proverbial saying among** the nations, a shaking of the head **among** the national groups. (**Psalms 44:14**)
- So the land should not be sold in perpetuity, because the land is mine. For **you** are alien residents and settlers from my standpoint. (**Leviticus 25:23**)
- And Yehowah the God of their forefathers kept sending against them by means of his messengers, sending again and again, because he felt compassion for his people and for his dwelling. (**2 Chronicles 36:15**)
- I also, for my part, shall laugh at **YOUR** own disaster, I shall mock when what **you** dread comes. (**Proverbs 1:26**)
- This is what Yehowah has said against all my bad neighbors, who are touching the hereditary possession that I caused my people, even Israel, to possess; Here I am uprooting them from off their **ground**, and the **house** of Judah I shall **uproot** from the midst of them. (**Jeremiah 12:14**)
- And all those of flesh must see that I myself, Yehowah, **have** set it afire, so that it will not be extinguished. (**Ezekiel 20:48**)
- By your blood that you **have** shed you **have** become guilty, and by your dungy idols that you **have** made you **have** become unclean. And you bring your days near, and you will come to your years. That is why I must **make** you an object of reproach to the nations and of jeering to all the lands. (**Ezekiel 22:4**)
