

Numbers 12:8 **Mouth to mouth I speak to him, thus showing him, and not by riddles, and the appearance of Yehowah is what he beholds. Why, then, did you not fear to speak against my servant, against Moses?**

[18] - References:

- And **Yehowah** spoke to **Moses** face to face, just as a man would **speak** to his fellow. When he returned to the camp, his minister Joshua, the son of Nun, as attendant, would not withdraw from the midst of the tent. (**Exodus 33:11**)
- But there has never yet risen up a prophet in Israel like **Moses**, whom **Yehowah** knew face to face. (**Deuteronomy 34:10**)
- To a proverbial utterance I shall incline my ear, on a harp I shall open up my riddle. (**Psalms 49:4**)
- For at present we see in hazy outline by means of a metal mirror, but then it will be face to face. At present I know partially, but then I shall know accurately even as I am accurately known. (**1 Corinthians 13:12**)
- And they got to see the God of Israel. And under his feet there was **what** seemed like a work of sapphire flagstones and like the very heavens for purity. (**Exodus 24:10**)
- When Aaron and all the sons of Israel got to see **Moses**, why, look! The skin of his face emitted rays and they grew afraid of coming near to him. (**Exodus 34:30**)
- Especially, however, those who go on after flesh with the desire to defile it and who look down on lordship. Daring, self-willed, they do not tremble at glorious ones but **speak** abusively. (**2 Peter 2:10**)
- In like manner, notwithstanding, these men, too, indulging in dreams, are defiling the flesh and disregarding lordship and speaking abusively of glorious ones. (**Jude 1:8**)
- Then **Moses** said to his father-in-law; Because the people keep coming to me to inquire of God. (**Exodus 18:15**)

- After that all the people answered unanimously and said; All that **Yehowah** has spoken we are willing to do. Immediately **Moses** took back the words of the people to **Yehowah**. (**Exodus 19:8**)
- And **Yehowah** went on to say to **Moses**; This is **what** you are to say to the sons of Israel; **You** yourselves have seen that it was from the heavens I spoke with **you**. (**Exodus 20:22**)
- And **Moses** by himself must approach **Yehowah**, but they should not approach, and the people should not go up with him. (**Exodus 24:2**)
- Now whenever **Moses** went into the tent of meeting to **speak** with him, then he would hear the voice conversing with him from above the cover that was upon the ark of the testimony, from between the two cherubs, and he would **speak** to him. (**Numbers 7:89**)
- And I shall have to come down and **speak** with you there, and I shall have to take away some of the spirit that is upon you and place it upon them, and they will have to help you in carrying the load of the people that you may not carry it, just you alone. (**Numbers 11:17**)
- Then David said to him; How was it that you did not **fear** to thrust your hand out to bring the anointed of **Yehowah** to ruin? (**2 Samuel 1:14**)
- For you yourself separated them as your inheritance out of all the peoples of the earth, just as you have spoken by means of **Moses** your **servant** when you were bringing our forefathers out from Egypt, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**1 Kings 8:53**)
- He made known his ways to **Moses**, this dealings even to the sons of Israel. (**Psalms 103:7**)
- God, who long ago spoke on many occasions and in many ways to our forefathers by means of the prophets. (**Hebrews 1:1**)
