- And the Jebusite and the Amorite and the Girgashite. (**Genesis 10:16**)
- But in the fourth generation they will return here, because the error of the **Amorites** has not yet come to completion. (**Genesis 15:16**)
- And I am proceeding to go down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land to a land good and spacious, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the locality of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the **Amorites** and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. (**Exodus 3:8**)
- When Yehowah your God at last brings you into the land to which you are going so as to take possession of it, he must also clear away populous nations from before you, the Hittites and the Girgashites and the **Amorites** and the Canaanites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites, seven nations more populous and mighty than you are. (**Deuteronomy 7:1**)
- Then I sent messengers from the wilderness of Kedemoth to Sihon the king of **Heshbon** with words of peace, saying; (**Deuteronomy 2:26**)
- After that **Israel** sent messengers to Sihon the king of the **Amorites**, the king of **Heshbon**, and **Israel** said to him; Let us pass, please, through your land to my own place. (**Judges 11:19**)
- Your neck is like an ivory tower. Your eyes are like the pools in **Heshbon**, by the gate of Bath-rabbim. Your nose is like the tower of Lebanon, which is looking out toward Damascus. (**Song of Solomon 7:4**)
- Then Moses sent some to spy on Jazer. So they captured its **dependent towns** and dispossessed the **Amorites** who were there. (**Numbers 21:32**)

- And Sihon the king of **Heshbon** did not let us pass through him, because Yehowah your God had let his spirit become obstinate and his heart become hard, in order to give him into your hand just as at this day. (**Deuteronomy 2:30**)
- **Heshbon** and all its **towns** that are on the tableland, Dibon and Bamoth-baal and Beth-baal-meon. (**Joshua 13:17**)
- And all the **cities** of the tableland and all the royal realm of Sihon the king of the **Amorites**, who reigned in **Heshbon**, and whom Moses struck, together with the chieftains of Midian, Evi and Rekem and Zur and Hur and Reba, the dukes of Sihon, who were **dwelling** in the land. (**Joshua 13:21**)
- Then Yehowah said to the sons of **Israel**; Was it not from Egypt and from the **Amorites** and from the sons of Ammon and from the Philistines (**Judges 10:11**)
- While **Israel** was **dwelling** in **Heshbon** and its **dependent towns** and in Aroer and its **dependent towns** and in all the **cities** that are by the banks of Arnon for three hundred years, why, then, did you never snatch them away during that time? (**Judges 11:26**)
- From the cry in **Heshbon** clear to Elealeh, clear to Jahaz they have given forth their voice, from Zoar clear to Horonaim, to Eglath-shelishiyah, for even the waters of Nimrim themselves will become mere desolations. (**Jeremiah 48:34**)
- Therefore, look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah; and I will cause the alarm signal of war to be heard even against Rabbah of the sons of Ammon, and she will certainly become a mound of a desolate waste, and her **dependent towns** themselves will be set aflame in the very fire. And **Israel** will actually take possession of those in possession of him, Yehowah has said. (**Jeremiah 49:2**)
