- In the shadow of **Heshbon** those fleeing have stood still without power. For a very fire will certainly go forth **out** of **Heshbon**, and a **flame** from the midst of **Sihon**, and it will devour the temples of **Moab** and the crown of the head of the sons of uproar. (**Jeremiah 48:45**)
- And the mouth of the torrent valleys, which **has** bent itself toward the seat of Ar and **has** leaned against the border of Moab. (**Numbers 21:15**)
- Yehowah then said to me; Do not molest **Moab** or engage in war with them, because I shall not give you any of his land as a holding, for to the sons of Lot I have given Ar as a holding. (**Deuteronomy 2:9**)
- You are passing today by the territory of **Moab**, that is, Ar. (**Deuteronomy 2:18**)
- The pronouncement against **Moab**; Because in the night it **has** been despoiled, Ar of **Moab** itself **has** been silenced. Because in the night it **has** been despoiled, Kir of **Moab** itself **has** been silenced. (**Isaiah 15:1**)
- **Moab has** been broken down. Her little ones have caused a cry to be heard. (**Jeremiah 48:4**)
