

Numbers 26:64· But among these there did not prove to be a man of those registered by Moses and Aaron the priest when they registered the sons of Israel in the wilderness of Sinai.

[9] - References:

- **TAKE** the sum of the whole assembly of the **sons of Israel** according to their families, according to the house of their fathers, by the number of names, all the males, head by head of them. (**Numbers 1:2**)
- And the days that we walked from Kadesh-barnea until we crossed the torrent valley of Zered were thirty-eight years, until all the generation of the men of war had come to their end from the midst of the camp, just as Yehowah had sworn to them. (**Deuteronomy 2:14**)
- Nevertheless, on most of them God did not express his approval, for they were laid low in the **wilderness**. (**1 Corinthians 10:5**)
- However, the Levites according to the tribe of their fathers did not get **registered** in **among** them. (**Numbers 1:47**)
- Will never see the land about which I swore to their fathers, yes, all those treating me without respect will not see it. (**Numbers 14:23**)
- Say to them; As I live, is the utterance of Yehowah, if I shall not do to **you** just that way as **you** have spoken in my ears! (**Numbers 14:28**)
- Why should the name of our father be taken away from the midst of his family because he had no son? O give us a possession in the midst of our father's brothers. (**Numbers 27:4**)
- So Yehowah's anger blazed against **Israel** and he made them wander about in the **wilderness** forty years, until all the generation that was doing evil in the eyes of Yehowah came to their end. (**Numbers 32:13**)
- And it came about that as soon as all the men of war had finished dying off from the midst of the people. (**Deuteronomy 2:16**)
