

Numbers 32:13 So Yehowah's anger blazed against Israel and he made them wander about in the wilderness forty years, until all the generation that was doing evil in the eyes of Yehowah came to their end.

- And **YOUR** sons will become shepherds in the **wilderness forty years**, and they will have to answer for **YOUR** acts of fornication, **until YOUR** carcasses come to their **end** in the **wilderness**. (**Numbers 14:33**)
- While I kept guiding **you forty years** in the **wilderness**, **YOUR** garments did not wear out upon **you**, and your sandal did not wear out upon your foot. (**Deuteronomy 29:5**)
- For the sons of **Israel** had walked **forty years** in the **wilderness**, **until** all the nation of the men of war who **came** out of Egypt that did not listen to the voice of **Yehowah** had come to its finish, to whom **Yehowah** swore that he would never let them see the land that **Yehowah** had sworn to their forefathers to give to us, a land flowing with milk and honey. (**Joshua 5:6**)
- For **forty years** I kept feeling a loathing toward that **generation**, and I proceeded to say; They are a people wayward at heart, and they themselves have not come to know my ways. (**Psalms 95:10**)
- This man led them out after **doing** portents and signs in Egypt and in the Red Sea and in the **wilderness** for **forty years**. (**Acts of Apostles 7:36**)
- And for a period of **about forty years** he put up with their manner of action in the **wilderness**. (**Acts of Apostles 13:18**)
- But among these there did not prove to be a man of those registered by Moses and Aaron the priest when they registered the sons of **Israel** in the **wilderness** of Sinai. (**Numbers 26:64**)
- And the days that we walked from Kadesh-barnea **until** we crossed the torrent valley of Zered were thirty-eight **years**, **until** all the **generation** of the men of war had come to their **end** from the midst of the camp, just as **Yehowah** had sworn to them. (**Deuteronomy 2:14**)

- **Nevertheless, on most of them God did not express his approval, for they were laid low in the wilderness. (1 Corinthians 10:5)**
- **Moreover, with whom did God become disgusted for forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness? (Hebrews 3:17)**
- **And it came about that in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first of the month, Moses spoke to the sons of Israel according to all that Yehowah had commanded him for them. (Deuteronomy 1:3)**
- **In which YOUR forefathers made a test of me with a trial, and yet they had seen my works for forty years. (Hebrews 3:9)**
