

**Numbers 5:3**· **Whether a male or a female you should send them out. You should send them outside the camp, that they may not contaminate the camps of those in the midst of whom I am tabernacling.**

[9] - References:

- **And there were four men, lepers, that happened to be at the entrance of the gate, and they began to say the one to the other; Why are we sitting here until we have died? (2 Kings 7:3)**
- **And anything the unclean one may touch will be unclean, and the soul who touches it will be unclean until the evening. (Numbers 19:22)**
- **And they must make a sanctuary for me, as I must tabernacle in the midst of them. (Exodus 25:8)**
- **And I shall certainly put my tabernacle in the midst of you, and my soul will not abhor you. (Leviticus 26:11)**
- **Now if it is indeed that the land of YOUR possession is unclean, make YOUR way across to the land of Yehowah's possession where the tabernacle of Yehowah has resided, and get settled in our midst, and against Yehowah do not YOU rebel and do not make us the ones to rebel by YOUR building for yourselves an altar in addition to the altar of Yehowah our God. (Joshua 22:19)**
- **And what agreement does God's temple have with idols? For we are a temple of a living God, just as God said; I shall reside among them and walk among them, and I shall be their God, and they will be my people. (2 Corinthians 6:16)**
- **He must have the entire bull taken out to the outskirts of the camp to a clean place where the fatty ashes are poured out, and he must burn it upon wood in the fire. Where the fatty ashes are poured out it should be burned. (Leviticus 4:12)**
- **And you must keep the sons of Israel separate from their uncleanness, that they may not die in their uncleanness for their defiling of my tabernacle, which is in their midst. (Leviticus 15:31)**
- **Bring forth the one who called down evil to the outside of the camp, and all those who heard him must lay their hands upon his**

**head, and the entire assembly must pelt him with stones.  
(Leviticus 24:14)**
